Waterloo Local School District - Track Use Rules:

Hours of Operation

The track is open for community use from dawn to dusk, outside of school events and practices.

Track Use Only

Please use the track for walking or running only.

No bikes, scooters, skateboards, or motorized vehicles allowed.

Footwear

Wear appropriate athletic shoes. No cleats, spikes, or shoes that could damage the track surface.

Cleanliness:

Keep the track and surrounding areas clean. Dispose of all trash in designated bins. No food or drink (other than water) on the track.

Pets:

NO pets/animals

Respect for Others:

Be mindful of other users. Walkers should stay to the inside lanes, leaving the outer lanes for runners. Pass on the outside.

No Smoking or Alcohol:

Smoking, Vaping, alcohol, and drugs are prohibited on school property.

Supervision of Children:

Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

No Loitering or Unauthorized Gatherings:

Use the track for its intended purpose. No unauthorized gatherings, events, or activities without prior approval from the school district.

School Events Take Priority:

The track will be closed to the public during school events, practices, or maintenance.

Please check the schedule or district website for updates.

Personal Responsibility:

Use the track at your own risk. The school district is not responsible for accidents or injuries.
