## Opening

The regular meeting of the Shenandoah PTO was called to order at 6:04pm on October 20, 2022 by Stephanie Parkkila.

## Principal's Report

Principal Houghton gave the principal's report.

- iReady Beginning of Year data for math and reading were referenced, as well as the School Improvement Plan, new hires, and vacancies.
- Opening the morning computer lab by the end of October/beginning of November. Purchasing a separate reading program (not iReady) based on the student's reading level. The new instructional coach is purchasing the instructional program and will be running the lab, probably twice a week.
- Ilona Grommlich will be running science labs for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. Looking to have parents come in and help with labeling and minor organizing. The first lab will be October 21, and then there will be designated days. Talked about importance of science in education. May request support of PTO for items needed in the lab (salt, sugar, cups).
- Typing club is going once a week on Mondays at 7:45am. Thursday is Chess Club at 7:45am. Both are for third through fifth grades. Battle of the Books will be starting Wednesdays at 7:45am, questions relating to Sunshine State Books and students will go "battle" other schools. Amy Dannemiller gave additional information.
- Sign-up for Additions. Need to be Addition-approved just to be on campus. Ilona Grommlich gave more details.
- October 27, 2022 – Student of the Month lunches, parents are welcome to join for lunch that day for a little celebration. This month is for September and October Students of the Month, then each will have lunch on their special month. Certificates will be given to students after they are taken off the wall. Ilona Grommlich mentioned that lunch is not provided for parents, kids may have school lunch or lunch brought from home.
- Vocabulary Parade – October 31<sup>st</sup> at 9am. The parade was explained by Amy Dannemiller. Decisions on how parent attendance can be done with the parade route are being discussed.

## Treasurer's Report

The October 2022 Treasurer's Report was presented by Stephanie Parkkila. The opening balance was \$22,326, then had an income of \$9,487.09 and expenses of \$8,334.82. The Book Balance was \$23,478, with a Bank account amount of \$23,790.00. The difference was due to a pending school pay fee of \$311.73. Revenue and expenses were discussed in detail. Approximately \$800-900 more revenue is expected, pending payments for Silent Auction items. Motion for approval by Alison Asbury, seconded by Amy Dannemiller. Unanimously approved.

A big thank you was given to those who helped with the school carnival and how much it meant to teachers, staff, and students.

## New Business

- **P.E. Grant:** Ms. Sharpe presented on the state of P.E. equipment. Has some things already, looking at other avenues of getting equipment and money, and is getting quotes, but would like to get a grant from PTO so can start accumulating needed equipment. Have 8 scooters, need 20. Need cones, some basic things are needed every day that the school just doesn't have. Other specific items discussed. Gave estimates of quotes, discussed the need of specialized PE equipment due to long-life durability and large quantities that can't be

bought at normal stores. Amy Dannemiller made a motion for \$1500, Crystal Wiseman seconded. Unanimous approval.

### Approval of Minutes

September 2022 meeting minutes were presented. Name spellings were noted that needed to be corrected. Kim Triplett moved to approve. Crystal Wiseman seconded. Unanimously approved.

Amy Dannemiller gave the communications report.
