2026 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Eligibility:

- Geography:
 - Enrolled in a public or private high school (or home-schooled) in the Hampton Roads Post geographic footprint (Southeast Virginia)
- College/university enrollment:
 - Enrolled in a full-time undergraduate STEM-related degree program at an accredited college or university in the Fall term of 2026. Applicants that will be enrolled at a community college or two-year college in the Fall term of 2026 **are not eligible**.
 - Applicants who receive an appointment to a U.S. military academy (or affiliated preparatory school) or who are awarded a full scholarship at their college/university **are not eligible** to receive a scholarship from SAME Hampton Roads Post. A full scholarship is usually defined as one that provides for total payment of tuition, room and board, books, and lab fees. If an applicant becomes aware of such ineligibility after submitting the application, it is expected that the applicant will notify the point of contact identified below and withdraw the application.
- Grade point average (GPA):
 - Minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 basis).
- SAME student membership
 - Applicants are not required to be SAME members; however, preference will be given to student members.
 - Student membership is free and attainable. Information can be found at <https://www.same.org/membership-communities/join/student-membership/>.

How to apply:

- Complete the enclosed application and provide the identified supporting information.
 - Previous versions of this application will not be accepted. Scoring criteria are included as Attachment A.
 - If additional pages are needed, note this in the associated section(s) of the application form and clearly identify the content on the additional page(s) to correspond to the specific item from the application.
- **The completed application packages, including application form, essay, transcripts, and letter of recommendation, must be received no later than 03 April 2026.**
 - Send a legible/electronic copy of the completed application package to samehr.scholarship@gmail.com.
 - Provide the application package (other than the letter of recommendation) as a single submittal to include all required components.
 - All letters of recommendation must be sent directly to samehr.scholarship@gmail.com by the author of the letter and not from the applicant.** It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure the letter is submitted by the author before the deadline. See the application form for additional instructions.

- Must be authored by a SAME Post or National member **or** by a guidance counselor or high school teacher of a STEM-related course that has directly advised/instructed the applicant.
 - o **This letter may not be written by a family member, including members related by marriage or other family-like relationship.**
- Must address the merit/achievements of the applicant and the potential for success of the applicant in the chosen STEM field
- Must be addressed to the SAME Hampton Roads Post Scholarship Committee and must be signed (either original or certified digital) and dated by the author. If written by a SAME Post or National member, the member number and Post affiliation must be included with the signature.
- Must be submitted to samehr.scholarship@gmail.com no later than 03 April 2026. The email submittal must have the applicant's name in the subject line.
