## Eligibility:

Applicant must be a U.S. citizen, A resident and registered voter of Whiteside County.

Graduating High School seniors – applicants must be currently a Whiteside County high school senior, planning to attend a two- or four-year college or trade school in the fall of 2025.

Applicants must be ranked in the upper 10% of their high school graduating class or a member of the National Honors Society.

College or Trade school students – applicants must be currently attending a two or four-year college or trade school. The college or trade school can be located anywhere in Illinois or any other state. A current GPA of a minimum 3.25 out of 4.00 is required.

## Scholarship Criteria:

Applicant is capped at receiving scholarship from Whiteside County Republicans twice (\$2000)

Applicant is to submit a copy of the letter of acceptance from an accredited college or trade school.

If already attending a college or trade school, the applicant must submit a copy of a transcript from said college or trade school.

If applicant is graduating High School, applicant must submit copy of High School Transcript.

All applicants must submit two letters of recommendation.

All applications must be typed. Handwritten responses will not be accepted.

All applicants will have an in-person interview with four scholarship committee members.

All Applications must be turned in/post marked on or before March 14th, 2025.
