

Senior Parking Space Painting

We're excited to offer seniors the opportunity to personalize their parking spot this year! Please carefully read through the following guidelines to ensure a safe, respectful, and fun painting day.

Painting Dates & Times

- Friday, July 31st, from 5:30-10:30 AM
- Saturday, August 1st, from 5:30-10:30 AM
- Friday, August 7th, from 6-10 PM
- Saturday, August 8th, from 5:30-10:30 AM
 - Students **must** complete their spot during these designated times. There will be no painting outside these dates.

Design Requirements

1. **Must leave a 6-inch border** around the entire spot (not too close to parking lines).
2. **Design must end 6 inches above parking spot number.**
3. Design must respect human dignity and be positive/uplifting.
4. No political messages, symbols, or ideologies (ie-political slogans, politician names, images representing political parties, etc.)
5. No references to sex, drugs, alcohol, weapons, or violence.
6. No vulgar words, gestures, or coded slang.
7. No copyrighted logos or characters (e.g., Disney, sports teams logos, brands).
8. Design must not contradict Church teachings.
9. Design should not be overly chaotic—must be easy to view and enjoy.
10. No use of names or initials other than that of the student
11. No use of images of other Sentinels, or images of other people in inappropriate attire
12. No inappropriate album covers/songs
13. All designs must receive administrative approval before painting
 - a. Designs **MUST** be submitted [via Google Form submission](#) **NO LATER THAN July 24th, 2026.**
 - i. Submitted designs **MUST** be complete and in the color you will be painting.
 - b. Rejected designs must be corrected and re-submitted.

Painting Rules

- Only water-based, exterior latex paint is allowed (NO spray paint, oil-based, reflective, glitter, or textured materials).
- A white base coat is strongly recommended to help colors stand out and last.
- No raised objects, adhesives, stickers, or other 3D additions.
- Students are responsible for **all cleanup**—including trash, spills, and supplies.
- **BRING TRASHBAGS:** All leftover paint, supplies, and trash **MUST** be taken home for proper disposal—nothing can be left on school grounds.
- If rules are violated, the spot may be painted over at the student's expense, and parking privileges may be revoked.

What to Bring

Students must supply their own materials, including:

- Paint (water-based exterior latex only)
- Brushes, **rollers**, paint trays, handles for attaching rollers
- Painter's tape (for clean borders)
- Chalk (to sketch design before painting)
- Drop cloths or cardboard (to prevent spills)
- Trash bags (to clean up after yourself)

Optional (but encouraged for comfort!):

- Pop-up tents, chairs, snacks, and water – stay hydrated and shaded while working.
- Chalk to sketch your drawing before painting
- A broom/leaf-blower to help clean your spot before painting

Helpful Tips

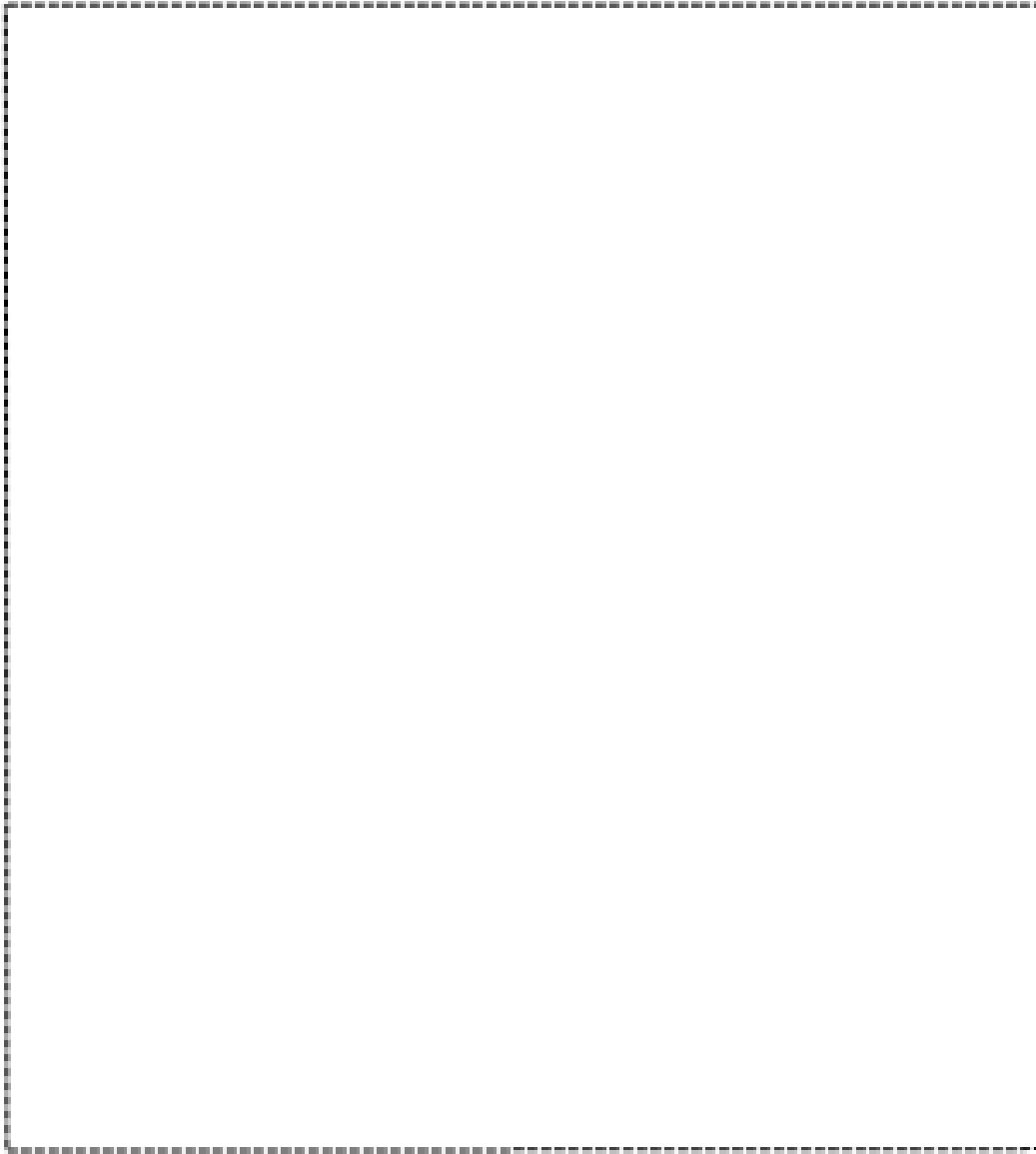
- Plan your design and keep it simple—large shapes and bold colors look best.
- Partner up with friends – sharing paint and supplies saves money, reduces waste, and makes the day more fun!
- The use of stencils is highly encouraged. You can make them yourself or have a company do it for you. Below are some online options:

- Work light to dark (white/yellow first, black details last).
- Let paint dry fully between layers to avoid smearing.
- Take photos of your masterpiece!

- There is a \$65 fee to paint your parking space. Fees will be collected via FACTS account.
- Designs must be submitted in advance for approval before painting day. Designs are due **NO LATER THAN July 24th, 2026 via Google Form**.
