Assessment Policy

Year 12

The enclosed schedules are provided to give an overview of the assessments for the next four terms. While many tasks and weeks will not change from what is set on the schedule enclosed, the specific date of the given task will be found on the Canvas LMS and the latest version of Policies can be found on the school website under the link [Community Portal](#).

Policy Scope and Purpose

This policy relates to the New South Wales Education Standards Authority (NESA) requirements for determining the provision of an assessment achievement for each course undertaken as a candidate for the Record of School Achievement (Year 11) and Higher School Certificate (HSC).

The purpose of Year 12 school assessment is to provide an indication of student achievement in a wider range of syllabus objectives and outcomes than can be measured by the external examination. It uses multiple measures and observations made throughout the HSC course rather than a single assessment event ([ACE Rule 2.1.2](#)). Therefore, assessment covers both examination and non-examination objectives.

Internal Assessment Program

NESA requires an assessment program to be prepared for each course based on the provided assessment and reporting documents, indicating the mandatory components and weightings for HSC assessments. Students are to be advised of:

- an assessment schedule developed by each faculty, indicating the number of tasks, timing of each assessment task, and the mark value (weighting) of each task in relation to the total number of marks for the course
- the nature of each assessment task (e.g. assignment, test, project, etc.)
- details of administrative arrangements associated with each task
- details of the school's policy on malpractice in assessment tasks
- details of the procedures to be implemented if tasks produce invalid or unreliable results. Note that the results of assessment tasks that have been completed by the student generally cannot be discarded;
- details of the procedures for dealing with student appeals arising from assessment tasks.

Assessment programs will begin at the start of the Higher School Certificate (HSC) course. There will be non-assessment times during this period, especially during the week leading up to the Trial HSC Examinations, unless the assessment task is an in-class task that requires no preparation, or it is part of the Trial HSC Examination such as in Science (Practical), Languages, Music and Drama.

For the purposes of this policy the term 'absent' refers to a student being physically absent from school. It also includes students studying via Distance Education who fail to attend a specified on-campus task, fail to submit a task that includes a specified date and or time for completion, or fail to attend a student learning program, either in-person or virtually.

Criteria for satisfactory completion of a course

Completion of the assessment program is a requirement for the award of a HSC. Years 11 and 12 are divided into Preliminary and HSC courses. Satisfactory course completion criteria refer to both Preliminary and HSC courses.

Completion of the assessment program is a requirement for the award of a HSC. A student will be considered to have satisfactorily completed a course if, in the Principal's view ([ACE 4.1.2](#)), there is sufficient evidence that the student has:

- followed the course developed or endorsed by the Board; and
- applied themselves with diligence and sustained effort to the set tasks and experiences provided in the course by the school; and
- achieved some or all of the course outcomes.

Candidates for the HSC who do not comply with the assessment requirements in any course will not have a moderated assessment mark, nor an examination mark awarded for that course. In the case of extension courses, students who fail to meet the assessment requirements of the common part of the course will not receive a result in the course at all.

Patterns of study and course requirements

Students must satisfactorily complete:

- a Higher School Certificate pattern of study that includes at least 10 units.

Both patterns of study must include at least:

- 2 units of a Board Developed Course in English, or English Studies
- At least 4 more units of Board Developed Courses
- At least 3 courses of 2 units value or greater (either Board Developed or Board Endorsed Courses)
- At least 4 subjects (including English).

Some courses have certain rules and prerequisites. To be eligible for an ATAR, students must [satisfactorily complete](#) at least 10 units of ATAR courses. These ATAR courses must include at least:

- 8 units from Category A courses
- 2 units of English
- three Board Developed courses of 2 units or greater
- four subjects.

The ATAR is then calculated from a students':

- best 2 units of English
- best 8 units from your remaining units, which can include no more than 2 units of Category B courses.

Types of Assessments

There are five types of formal assessments that students may be required to complete during their courses. For On-Campus and Distance Education students in the same course, there are common assessment tasks, however, there may be different procedures around ensuring equitable assessment conditions for every student in each mode.

These variations are outlined in the table below.
