Scrabble Vaccination Registry FAQ

What is the Scrabble Vaccination Registry?

• The Scrabble Vaccination Registry is a voluntary, opt-in list of players who have provided proof of Covid-19 vaccination for the purpose of playing Scrabble tournaments. This registry does not attempt to track vaccination status for all Scrabble players - it is a convenience for players and directors who opt-in, in order to avoid providing this information at each and every tournament. IMPORTANT: The registry shows that proof of vaccination has been received, but it's important to know that this does not mean the submission has been authenticated.

Why should I register?

 If you're a Scrabble player who competes in multiple events a year, getting registered with the Scrabble Vaccine Registry is for you! Provide your proof of vaccination once, and then participating directors will have access to that information. That way, you don't have to provide proof each time you participate in a tournament. As a Scrabble director, this will save you time chasing down players for their information.

How do I register?

Who receives/reviews the proof of vaccination?

• The participating director will review your proof of vaccination, then add your name to the registry. Once your name has been added, the proof that you provided will be discarded.

Who gets access to this information?

• Tournament directors who participate in the registry will only have access to your name and/or organization ID, in order to confirm that you've submitted proof of vaccination.

Who is overseeing this project?

- Josh Greenway and Kieran O'Connor created the Scrabble Vaccination Registry. Additional directors have been invited to participate. This registry is not affiliated with any organization, including NASPA, Hasbro, or Mattel.
- The SVR is provided for players and directors as a courtesy, we assume no liability for the information provided by individuals to us. Tournament directors who have questions about players' vaccination records may contact players directly.
