- Trams 16, 63 or 66 to Heussallee/Museumsmeile

What to do in Bonn

Capital of West Germany until 1990, and now an internationally renowned hub of commerce, culture and sustainability, the city of Bonn offers a wide range of activities.

Here are some of our top recommendations of what to do in Bonn:

- Rheinaue Park: Stroll through the beautiful Rheinaue Park along the Rhine River, located right next to the conference venue. This park offers picturesque landscapes, including lakes, gardens and meadows, and is ideal for walking, picnicking or even renting a paddle boat.
- Beethoven House: As the birthplace of Ludwig van Beethoven, Bonn celebrates its most famous son with the Beethoven House museum, which features original manuscripts, letters and personal items offering deep insights into his life.
- Art: Explore two of Germany's best art museums – the Bonn Museum of Modern Art and the Art and Exhibition Hall of the Federal Republic of Germany (Bundeskunsthalle).
