- -CoGat: CogAT stands for the Cognitive Abilities Test, an assessment that measures a student's general reasoning abilities in three domains: verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal. It helps identify a student's cognitive development and academic potential.
- -Connection Card Survey October: students fill out a survey that asks students if they have a friend, feel like they belong, and have a preferred adult they trust/can talk to
- -Attendance / Tardies: The school monitors attendance and tardies, letters are shared with families who are absent more than 10% of the school year
