Minutes of November 18, 2022

The Venerable Master Pro Tem, HB Baron Conklin, 32°, KCCH opened the Lodge of Perfection at 7:00 p.m. by proclamation. After the opening prayer the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed by all.

The minutes of October 21, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

At this time guests were invited into the Lodge Room. Scottish Rite members introduced their spouses in attendance. HB Roger Buterbaugh, 32°, KCCH also introduced his Mother who is in attendance and announced her 90th birthday at the end of the month. She received a round of applause.

The Personal Representative introduced our guest speaker for the evening, IB James H. "Chuck" Morgan III, 33°, Major Donor Officer for the Supreme Council. He gave a presentation on Albert Pike's sword. Afterwards he spoke about the Acacia Fund. HB Joseph Oelgoetz, 32°, KCCH presented IB Morgan a Valley of Columbus certificate to thank him for his presentation.

- Announced the Membership meeting at Tyrian Lodge #111 on February 11 and the guests from Supreme Council.
