

Kindergarten Homework Description

March 14th- March 18th, 2022

1. Monday March 14th:

- a. Watch the letter formation video with your child posted on the BLOG. The video will demonstrate the proper letter formation for lowercase letter 'k'.
- b. Watch the sound video with your child posted on the BLOG. The video will demonstrate the sound and action that goes with the letter 'k'. There is one sound for the letter 'k'.
- c. On the homework sheet, practice printing 2 rows of lowercase letter 'k'. **Remember to have your child say the sound out loud as they are printing the letter.**
- d. Draw **a detailed picture** on the homework sheet that begins with the sound and letter for 'k' (e.g. kangaroo, koala bear, king). **A detailed picture has at least 3 details and 3-5 colours. Please make sure that your child adds details to the background of their picture.**
- e. Your child is starting to write sentences at school in their journal. As part of the homework your child will create a sentence to go with the picture they have drawn. Use the sentence starters I see, I like, I love, I am, I can, Here are, Here is a, Look at. Your child should use capitals, periods and finger spaces. Have your child try to sound out the word for their picture and write down the sounds they hear. **PLEASE DO NOT SPELL THE WORD FOR YOUR CHILD.**
- f. Review the sight words: blue, yellow, red

2. Tuesday March 15th:

- a. Watch the letter formation video with your child posted on the BLOG. The video will demonstrate the proper letter formation for uppercase letter 'K'.
- b. On the homework sheet, practice printing 2 rows of uppercase letter 'K'. **Remember to have your child say the sound out loud as they are printing the letter.** There is one sound for the letter 'K'.
- c. Draw **a detailed picture** on the homework sheet that begins with the sound and letter for 'K'. **Have your child draw a picture that is different from the one that was drawn on Monday. Remember a detailed picture has at least 3 details and 3-5 colours. Have your child add details to the background of their picture.**
- d. Your child is starting to write sentences at school in their journal. As part of the homework your child will create a sentence to go with the picture they have drawn. Use the sentence starters I see, I like, I love, I am or I can, Here are, Here is a, Look at. Your child should use capitals, periods and finger spaces. Have your child try to sound out the word for their picture and write down the sounds they hear. **PLEASE DO NOT SPELL THE WORD FOR YOUR CHILD.**
- e. Review the sight words: blue, yellow, red

3. Wednesday March 16th:

- a. Have your child complete a **detailed picture** of something they are good at (e.g. riding their bike, monkey bars, cartwheels, playing the piano, soccer etc). **A detailed picture has at least 3 details and 3-5 colours. Please make sure that your child adds details to the background of their picture.**
- b. Your child is starting to write simple sentences at school in their journal. As part of the homework your child will create a simple sentence to go with the picture they have drawn. Use the sentence starter 'I am good at'. Your child should use capitals, periods and finger spaces. Have your child try to sound out the word for their picture and write down the sounds they hear. **PLEASE DO NOT SPELL THE WORD FOR YOUR CHILD.**
- c. Review the sight words: blue, yellow, red
