What are possible questions that I may ask you?

Obviously, don't respond to all of these questions. These are just questions to think about going into your conversation.

1. Throughout this semester, we have emphasized classroom culture. Which component do you think is the most important (growth mindset, what it means to be a good group member or student led discussions) to creating a classroom culture and why?
2. How have you grown since the beginning of the year?
3. How have you done about revisiting my goal throughout the year?
4. Have you reached the goal that you set earlier in the year? If so, why? If not, why not?
5. How do you think your classmates perceive you in class?
6. How have you done collaborating with your classmates?
7. What risks have you taken throughout the year?
8. How persistent are you with difficult tasks? "An example where you were persistent was when..."
9. How have you challenged yourself this year?
10. What have you done to address any difficulties you have had this semester?
11. What does it look like when you're curious?
12. How have you done this year asking questions in your group? With the whole class?
13. What does it mean to experiment with problems? "An example of when I experimented on problem was when..."
14. What does it mean to you to have a growth mindset?
15. How have you changed as a group member?
16. What is your greatest strength as a group member? What is an area of growth within group work?
17. What is your favorite food?
18. What evidence do you have that you have grown in your area of focus?
19. What goals do you have for next semester?
20. What will you do to make sure that you actually follow through with your goals?
21. How have you contributed this year to class discussions?
22. How have you done with responding to feedback?
23. What is your willingness to share your ideas with your classmates? Has this changed since the beginning of the year?
24. How have you been at explaining your ideas? ("Now, explain it back to me")
25. How have you been with justifying your ideas?
26. What does helping a classmate look like to you? Describe an example where you demonstrated this.
27. How has this new grading system been for you?
28. Who is someone in class that you look up to? Why?
29. What goes through your head when you're facing a problem that you don't know how to do?
30. If your grade was solely based on what you did in class and nothing else, what grade do you think would have?
31. What do you think my expectations are of having an A?
