- Hours and Staffing: We're now open Friday—Sunday from 12–4. In June, we will expand
 our hours to Thursday—Sunday from 12–4. Gallery artists are asked to staff 1 shift in either
 May or June. Expanded hours will require additional staffing.
 - Now that Boston is reopening, what do we feel our hours should be going forward?

 - Do we increase our hours on Thursday–Sunday? Or only on specific days?
 - Do we go back to full regular hours starting in July?

- Marketing Ecosystem: We will begin a new marketing strategy going forward. We will focus

- 360 Tours: Special agreement, pro bono, scheduled through September. Cost is \$360/month after September, the gallery can not sustain this expense. The gallery currently owns the still images from the past tours, but the videos are hosted elsewhere and we only have access for 2 months past the tour launch. There is an additional monthly cost for longer term hosting.
 - What benefits/challenges do you see with keeping or removing the 360 Tours?
 - If we want to keep the 360 Tours: Since the Gallery can not cover this cost, what do
 we feel we should do after September? This is an all or nothing, it can not be
 optional.
 - Do we increase Core membership dues?
 - Do we make it an expected exhibition cost? Pay for it like we do for the window decals?
 - Do we increase Annex membership dues from \$450 to \$475 next year to help defray the costs? How do we cover the remaining cost?
 - What benefits/challenges do you see with increasing dues and/or paying out of pocket for your shows 360 Tour?

Sales

- **1stdibs featured listings:** During the pandemic, we began allocating funds to feature 2 pieces/week, rotating among artists. It costs \$10/listing, the item gets promoted for 1 week, brings attention to the listing and other works by that artist.
 - Is there any interest in being able to promote your work out of pocket outside of gallery paid promotions?
 - What benefits/challenges do you see with opening this promotion option for all Fountain Street 1stDibs artists?
 - If we move forward with this option you would have to pay the listing price, as well as processing fees.
