#### I. Introduction Paragraph

**Title** 

- Hook: Interesting fact about blood (Example: Your heart pumps about 2,000 gallons of blood each day!)
- Background information about the circulatory system
- Thesis statement: Blood flow is important because it carries oxygen and nutrients throughout our body

### II. Body Paragraph

- Main idea: How blood flows through the heart and body
- Supporting details:
  - o Blood starts in the heart
  - Travels through arteries
  - Moves through tiny blood vessels
  - o Returns through veins

# o Cycle repeats

# III. Conclusion Paragraph

- Restate thesis in different words
- Summarize main points about blood flow
- End with an interesting fact about the circulatory system
