f. Was any apparatus available or used? If so, what?	
g. Was rescued person helpless? Why?

j. Was applicant in great or considerable danger?	
k. Name, address and age of rescued person	
l. Where there people able to and willing to help?	
m. Did the applicant act alone or with assistance of others	

In application not involving drowning or fire, appropriate details should be given to facilitate proper judgment.

RULES COVERING AWARDS FOR GALLANTRY AND HEROISM

- I. A. The application for an Award for Gallantry and Heroism shall be submitted in the prescribed form.
B. A full account of the occurrence, substantiated by testimonies of eyewitness, shall be included in the application.
C. When the incident is not related to drowning or fire, appropriate details should be shown in the application to enable the National Court of Honor to pass proper judgment on the case.
D. The application shall not specify the award.
