Flight 1: Value: When in conflict, we ought to prioritize spending on public infrastructure over defense spending.

Flight 2: Value: Deep sea exploration ought to be prioritized over space exploration.

Round 2

Flight 1: Fact: Surveillance is necessary for national security.

Flight 2: Fact: Artificial Intelligence is eroding the value of traditional education.

Round 3

Flight 1: Policy: The U.S. federal government should implement a nationwide ban on single-use plastics.

Flight 2: Policy: The United States Federal Government should ban the use of bail bonds in the U.S. criminal justice system.

Round 4

Flight 1: Value: When in conflict, developing nations ought to prioritize economic growth over environmental protection.
