The first paragraph in the introduction explains the research problem, the background of the problem, the importance of the research, a brief literature review, previous research or findings, the novelty of the research, and ends with a paragraph about the research objectives, state of the art. The manuscript should consist of a minimum of 4000 words and a maximum of 6000 words, typed in one column on A4 paper, 1.15 spacing, using Times New Roman font, 12 pt. The manuscript should contain original work and have the potential to contribute significantly to scientific advancement.

RESEARCH METHOD

The research method is clearly written, including the research approach, data collection, and data analysis (Steps used in the research).

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

In this section, the results obtained have been processed and are not described raw. Well-prepared tables and figures should be the main feature of this section as they convey the key observations to the reader. The information provided in the tables and figures does not need to be repeated in the text, but the text should focus on the significance of the main findings of the research. Generally, the journal will contain three to seven figures and tables. The same data should not be presented in both table and figure form. The research results are discussed to answer the formulated problems, objectives, and research hypotheses. It is even better if there is a section before the Conclusion discussing the relevance of the issues studied to current life.

The content of the subchapter consists of topics and subtopics.

CONCLUSION

The conclusion contains the answers obtained and must be drawn based on the research findings, the concerns formulated, and the research objectives. The conclusion is presented in one paragraph without any numerical expressions. Explain the contribution of your research to science.

REFERENCES

All citations are expected to use a Reference Manager application: Mendeley, Zotero, etc., with APA (American Psychological Association 7th Edition) style (Wijaya, 2020). It is

preferable to use journals and books (70-80% journal articles & 20-30% books, etc.). References are expected to be from the last 5-10 years.

IMAGES

Images must have a minimum resolution of 300 dpi/1600 pixels (MUST be in black and white).

TABLES

If the article includes tables, a title must be provided, typed above the table in 12pt Times New Roman font. The word "Table" and the number should be bolded. The table should preferably be presented as an image, but it should also be typed using the real table-office word formatting.
