YEDA PLAN TO PROTECT AGAINST COVID-19

What We Know

- There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus (Covid 19)
- · The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus
- The virus is thought to spread mainly person to person
- It can be spread between people who are within close contact with one another and through respiratory droplets when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks.

What YEDA is Doing

- Following and respecting all CDC Guidelines
- Following and respecting all State and local health guidelines
- Limiting spectators and social distancing
- Allowing shows to be double judges so that only half of the riders need to be present on a day in the arena but riders can still receive two judges points
- · Placing hand sanitizer throughout the show facility and available at all times
 - Office
 - o Food booth
 - Paddock
- If any individual at a YEDA show displays visible symptoms of COVID 19, they will be required to leave the show
 premises by show management immediately and not return to the facility. Show management must enforce this
 strictly
- We are requiring each rider to use hand sanitizer prior to mounting and immediately after dismounting
- There will be designated mounting spots for each draw number to keep the paddock organized
- There will be strictly enforced limiting of the number of coaches and riders in the paddock at any given time
- Social distancing will be achieved by spacing out horses and horse holders as much as each facility allows
- Horses not in the next class can be held in separate area if the show facility allows
- No live horse draws Steward will conduct the draw with coaches witnessing
- Double tables to be provided for all vendors to allow for social distancing
- Only one person will hand out awards and that person will use hand sanitizer between each class
- Require teams to not have riders and parents at the show if they are not actively showing or needed to hold horses
- The majority of YEDA apparel sales will be done online to limit contact
- Masks are required indoors where social distancing cannot be achieved
 - o Masks are not required while riding or showing a horse
 - o If you have a health condition and cannot wear a mask, please turn in documentation to the show office

How Spectators and Riders Can Help

- If you feel ill or have been exposed to COVID-19, you MUST stay home
- Check our temperature prior to attending a YEDA event: if it is over 100.4 you MUST stay home
- Spectators, coaches, vendors, staff and riders must wear face masks when indoors where social distancing cannot be achieved.
 - o Riders may go without face masks immediately before their class, while mounting and while showing
 - A trash can for disposable masks will be located in the paddock for riders to dispose of their mask before riding
- Limit Spectators: we require that only 1 parent accompany a rider to a YEDA show if possible to limit the total number of people at the shows. Please no additional friends and family members as spectators.
- NO team food tables or community share tables will be allowed at the show
- Put a minimum of 6-foot distance between yourself and others whenever possible. If social distancing cannot be achieved, wear a face mask.
- Respect 6-foot distance in the seating area by sitting 3 seats away from anyone not in your group at all times
- Be respectful of new rules and guidelines and understand that for everyone's safety YEDA shows will look different this season
- Understand that this a fluid situation and be flexible to adjust to changes as they happen
- Listen to YEDA staff and follow all relevant instructions so that we can show while still maintaining the health and safety of all involved. Cooperation is mandatory and blatant disregard of the YEDA COVID rules will not be tolerated.

























Horse Descriptions

- 1. **Dustin (Rising Stars)-** Dun, nice reiner, support with strong leg and moderate support in face. Division appropriate spurs.
- 2. Sierra (Rising Stars)- Bay, reiner division appropriate spurs are optional. Keep soft contact on mouth.
- **3. Candy (Rising Stars)-** Ride on a slightly looser rein, old reiner, lots of leg, set up for left lead. Division appropriate spurs are optional.
- **4. Tammy (Rising Stars)-** Red roan, do not overbridle, can have a motor in run downs, division appropriate spurs are optional..
- **5. Goldie (Rising Stars)-** Can have a motor, be slow with leg and hand. No spurs.
- **6. Walter (Hancock)-** Reiner, has a flying lead change, can get forward in run downs so stay quiet and give him clear signals when it is acceptable to build. Division appropriate spurs and/or crop option. Can lose forward motion in the horsemanship and break gait.
- 7. **Wilbur (Hancock)-** Reiner, has a flying lead change, very honest horse, spins and stops with little assistance from the rider. Will hold his head out and drop his shoulder if he is allowed to, keep an organized rein length to be able to ask for collection from his nose to his hindquarters keeping him engaged with a correct bend. Keep him balanced between the reins. Division appropriate spurs.
- **8. Doda (Hancock)-** Very honest horse, can be lazy so make sure to do things with clarity and purpose. He has a spur stop but it is not necessary to use it. Has a flying lead change. Division appropriate spurs.
- **9. Banana (Green Country)-** Rides off of your seat and legs. Clear cues. Ride with 2 hands.
- 10. Reno (Green Country)- Lazy and tries to get out of work. Ride with contact and 2 hands.
- **11. Vinny (Red Dirt)-**Reiner, excellent in the ranch as well. Ride into stops, very easy lead change. Easy enough for lower level rail classes.
- **12. Dinero (NWA)-** Shows better one handed, will allow beginners two hands. Ride with light contact, she has a soft mouth and will collect if asked (hand and leg). Sit to stop. Backs easily.
- **13. Dally (NWA)-** Can ride one or two handed, based on beginner experience. Rides with light contact, will collect at the jog with hand and leg if asked. Sit to stop, backs easily.
- **14. Beaux (NWA)-** Can ride one or two handed, based on beginner experience. Ride with light contact, will collect at the jog if asked. Set up deliberately for leads. Sit to stop, backs easily.
- **15. Max (NWA)-** Ride one or two handed with light contact. Will collect with leg pressure. Use slow and easy cues, backs easily.
- **16. Armani (Harper)-** Extremely seasoned western pleasure horse, one hand or two, no spurs needed but can wear division appropriate spurs. Old and dependable horse.
- **17.** Harley (Black Diamond)- Old show horse. Can go with or without spurs. Prefers minimal contact with her face.
- 18. Sally (Black Diamond)- Show horse. Can go with or without spurs. Minimal contact with her face.
- **19.** Max (Black Diamond)- Works best with spurs. Need to set up for lead changes and spins. Light contact with face.
- 20. Chloe (Black Diamond)- Takes leg to make her go. Very kind old walk jog pony.
- 21. Tripp (Black Diamond)- Old show horse. Straight forward ride.
- 22. Gus (Buchs)- Very easy to ride. Point and shoot type ride. Listens to voice commands and legs.
- 23. Worm (Buchs)-Point and shoot ride. Voice commands and leg commands. Will STOP if you say whoa.
- 24. Zing (Buchs)-Voice and leg commands. Has a spur stop. Doesn't like people to dig their spurs in.
- 25. Beemer (Buchs)- SAT ONLY Soft legs and hand. Voice commands.
- **26.** Sox (Goins)- Straight forward, lots of leg, spurs optional, stay out of face. Division appropriate spurs optional
- 27. Molly (Goins)- Straight forward, use legs for steering, division appropriate spurs optional.
- **28. Max (Goins)-** Straight forward, use legs for steering, division appropriate spurs optional.
- **29. Batman (Goins)-** Hunt seat horse, sit deep for slower jog, STAY OUT OF FACE, ball spurs optional, don't get squeezed between horses.

YOUTH EQUESTRIAN

What We Know

- There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus (Covid 19)
- The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus
- The virus is thought to spread mainly person to person
- It can be spread between people who are within close contact with one another and through respiratory droplets when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks.

What YEDA is Doing

- Following and respecting all CDC Guidelines
- Following and respecting all State and local health guidelines
- Limiting spectators and social distancing
- Allowing shows to be double judges so that only half of the riders need to be present on a day in the arena but riders
 can still receive two judges points
- Placing hand sanitizer throughout the show facility and available at all times
 - Office
 - o Food booth
 - Paddock
- If any individual at a YEDA show displays visible symptoms of COVID 19, they will be required to leave the show
 premises by show management immediately and not return to the facility. Show management must enforce this
 strictly.
- We are requiring each rider to use hand sanitizer prior to mounting and immediately after dismounting
- There will be designated mounting spots for each draw number to keep the paddock organized
- There will be strictly enforced limiting of the number of coaches and riders in the paddock at any given time
- Social distancing will be achieved by spacing out horses and horse holders as much as each facility allows
- Horses not in the next class can be held in separate area if the show facility allows
- No live horse draws Steward will conduct the draw with coaches witnessing
- Double tables to be provided for all vendors to allow for social distancing
- Only one person will hand out awards and that person will use hand sanitizer between each class
- Require teams to not have riders and parents at the show if they are not actively showing or needed to hold horses
- The majority of YEDA apparel sales will be done online to limit contact
- Masks are required indoors where social distancing cannot be achieved
 - Masks are not required while riding or showing a horse
 - o If you have a health condition and cannot wear a mask, please turn in documentation to the show office

How Spectators and Riders Can Help

- If you feel ill or have been exposed to COVID-19, you MUST stay home
- Check our temperature prior to attending a YEDA event: if it is over 100.4 you MUST stay home
- Spectators, coaches, vendors, staff and riders must wear face masks when indoors where social distancing cannot be achieved.
 - o Riders may go without face masks immediately before their class, while mounting and while showing
 - A trash can for disposable masks will be located in the paddock for riders to dispose of their mask before riding
- Limit Spectators: we require that only 1 parent accompany a rider to a YEDA show if possible to limit the total number of people at the shows. Please no additional friends and family members as spectators.
- NO team food tables or community share tables will be allowed at the show
- Put a minimum of 6-foot distance between yourself and others whenever possible. If social distancing cannot be achieved, wear a face mask.
- Respect 6-foot distance in the seating area by sitting 3 seats away from anyone not in your group at all times
- Be respectful of new rules and guidelines and understand that for everyone's safety YEDA shows will look different this season
- Understand that this a fluid situation and be flexible to adjust to changes as they happen
- Listen to YEDA staff and follow all relevant instructions so that we can show while still maintaining the health and safety of all involved. Cooperation is mandatory and blatant disregard of the YEDA COVID rules will not be tolerated.


















NRHA Pattern 3



1.Beginning, lope straight up the left side of the arena, circle the top end of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six metres) from themsels or fence, run straight down the apposite or light side of the arena past the assets mentice and de a left refleated in a helatition.

2.Continue straight up the right side of the arena circle back around the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from thewalfs or fence, run straight down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollabet, non-hesitation.

3.Continue up the left side of the irena to the center marker. At the center marker, the horse should be on the right lead. Guide the horse to the zenter of the arena on the right lead and complete three circles to the right; the first two circles large and list, the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.

4.Complete three circles to the let: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads in the center of the arena.

5.Begin a large circle to the right rut do not close this circle. Continue up the left size of the arena, circle the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fenal, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up at least ten feet (https://marker.org/in/circles/feet).

6.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

7.Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate xempletion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

- **1. Dustin (Rising Stars)-** Dun, nice reiner, support with strong leg and moderate support in face. Division appropriate spurs.
- **2. Sierra (Rising Stars)-** Bay, reiner division appropriate spurs are optional. Keep soft contact on mouth.
- **3. Candy (Rising Stars)-** Ride on a slightly looser rein, old reiner, lots of leg, set up for left lead. Division appropriate spurs are optional.
- **4. Tammy (Rising Stars)-** Red roan, do not overbridle, can have a motor in run downs, division appropriate spurs are optional..
- 5. Goldie (Rising Stars)- Can have a motor, be slow with leg and hand. No spurs.
- **6. Walter (Hancock)-** Reiner, has a flying lead change, can get forward in run downs so stay quiet and give him clear signals when it is acceptable to build. Division appropriate spurs and/or crop option. Can lose forward motion in the horsemanship and break gait.
- 7. Wilbur (Hancock)- Reiner, has a flying lead change, very honest horse, spins and stops with little assistance from the rider. Will hold his head out and drop his shoulder if he is allowed to, keep an organized rein length to be able to ask for collection from his nose to his hindquarters keeping him engaged with a correct bend. Keep him balanced between the reins. Division appropriate spurs.
- **8. Doda (Hancock)-** Very honest horse, can be lazy so make sure to do things with clarity and purpose. He has a spur stop but it is not necessary to use it. Has a flying lead change. Division appropriate spurs.
- **9. Banana (Green Country)-** Rides off of your seat and legs. Clear cues. Ride with 2 hands.
- 10. Reno (Green Country)- Lazy and tries to get out of work. Ride with contact and 2 hands.
- **11. Vinny (Red Dirt)**-Reiner, excellent in the ranch as well. Ride into stops, very easy lead change. Easy enough for lower level rail classes.
- **12. Dinero (NWA)-** Shows better one handed, will allow beginners two hands. Ride with light contact, she has a soft mouth and will collect if asked (hand and leg). Sit to stop. Backs easily.
- **13. Dally (NWA)-** Can ride one or two handed, based on beginner experience. Rides with light contact, will collect at the jog with hand and leg if asked. Sit to stop, backs easily.
- **14. Beaux (NWA)-** Can ride one or two handed, based on beginner experience. Ride with light contact, will collect at the jog if asked. Set up deliberately for leads. Sit to stop, backs easily.
- **15. Max (NWA)-** Ride one or two handed with light contact. Will collect with leg pressure. Use slow and easy cues, backs easily.
- **16. Armani (Harper)-** Extremely seasoned western pleasure horse, one hand or two, no spurs needed but can wear division appropriate spurs. Old and dependable horse.
- **17. Harley (Black Diamond)-** Old show horse. Can go with or without spurs. Prefers minimal contact with her face.
- **18. Sally (Black Diamond)-** Show horse. Can go with or without spurs. Minimal contact with her face.
- **19. Max (Black Diamond)-** Works best with spurs. Need to set up for lead changes and spins. Light contact with face.
- **20.** Chloe (Black Diamond)- Takes leg to make her go. Very kind old walk jog pony.
- 21. Tripp (Black Diamond)- Old show horse. Straight forward ride.
- 22. Gus (Buchs)- Very easy to ride. Point and shoot type ride. Listens to voice commands and legs.
- 23. Worm (Buchs)-Point and shoot ride. Voice commands and leg commands. Will STOP if you say whoa
- 24. Zing (Buchs)-Voice and leg commands. Has a spur stop. Doesn't like people to dig their spurs in.
- 25. Beemer (Buchs)- SAT ONLY Soft legs and hand. Voice commands.
- **26.** Sox (Goins)- Straight forward, lots of leg, spurs optional, stay out of face. Division appropriate spurs optional.
- 27. Molly (Goins)- Straight forward, use legs for steering, division appropriate spurs optional.
- 28. Max (Goins)- Straight forward, use legs for steering, division appropriate spurs optional.
- **29. Batman (Goins)-** Hunt seat horse, sit deep for slower jog, STAY OUT OF FACE, ball spurs optional, don't get squeezed between horses.
