1st Asia Pacific Responsible Event Awards Terms & Conditions

1. Eligibility

1.1. The **1st Asia Pacific Responsible Event Awards** ("the Awards") are open to event companies, event venues, and educational institutions that have organized events contributing to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs).

1.2. Entrants may submit multiple event entries, but each entry must be submitted separately and include a unique portfolio of evidence.

1.3. The event(s) submitted must have taken place within the past two (2) years.

2. Entry Process

2.1. Entrants must submit a portfolio of evidence that demonstrates how their event(s) contribute to the attainment of the UN SDGs.

2.2. The portfolio may include written documents, reports, images, videos, case studies, testimonials, and any other relevant information.

2.3. Submissions must be uploaded to Google Drive, and a shareable link must be provided to the judging team.

2.4. The deadline for submission is **1st May 2025**. Late entries will not be accepted.

3. Entry Fee

3.1. A non-refundable entry fee of **USD 50** per single entry must be paid at the time of submission. If an organisation submits more than one entry, the USD50 entry fee must be paid for each one.

3.2. Entries will only be considered valid once payment has been received.

4. Judging Process

4.1. Entries will be reviewed by an independent panel of judges appointed by the Awards Committee.

4.2. Shortlisted applicants will be notified and invited to present their event at the **2nd Asia Pacific Summit for Event Leaders (APSEL2)** on **22nd – 23rd May 2025** at **Bali Tourism Polytechnic, Indonesia**.

4.3. Presentations may be delivered **in-person** or via **online, video submission**.

4.4. The judging panel's decision is **final**, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the selection process or final results.

5. Feedback and Confidentiality

5.1. Feedback on individual submissions will **not** be provided.

5.2. All information submitted will be treated with confidentiality and used solely for the purpose of evaluating the Awards entries.

5.3. By entering, applicants grant the Awards Committee permission to use their name, photo images, event details, and submission materials for promotional and marketing purposes.

6. Announcement of Winners

6.1. Winners will be announced at **APSEL2 on 22nd May 2025**.

6.2. Award winners may be required to participate in media activities related to the Awards.
