


You do not need to login to search your library catalog. You must login to your library account if you want to place a hold or check your account.

# Logging into your library account







## Step 3: Placing Holds



1. Search or browse for a title.
2. Click the Hold link in the lower right corner
3. A pop up window will tell you that your request has been received.
4. If the popup says your hold is ready, pick up before the date given. Note:.

### Check the status of a hold

From the Destiny Discover header, select and then Holds or My Stuff > Holds (look for 3 stacked lines in the upper left corner) to see all of your resources on hold. From this page, you can also:

- Open and/or check out a Follett eBook that is ready.
- Remove a hold that is not ready.
- Open the Title Details by selecting a title or cover image.
