## I. THE DIVINITY OF CHRIST

1. John 1:1-5; 14

v 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

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v. 2 He was with God in the beginning.

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v.3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

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v.4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

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v.14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

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## II. THE ATONEMENT THROUGH CHRIST

### 1. Definitions

- a. n. 1: a compensation for a wrong 2:the act of atoning for sin or wrong doing (especially appeasing a deity) (*Laridian Eng. Dict.*)
- b. In **Christian thought**, the act by which God and man are brought **together** in **personal relationships**. The term is derived from an Anglo-Saxon word meaning “**making at one**”, hence “**at-one-ment**.”
- c. It presupposes a separation or alienation that needs to be overcome. If human beings are to know God and have fellowship with him.
- d. As a term expressing relationship, atonement is tied closely to such terms as **reconciliation** and **forgiveness** (Tyndalee Bible Dict.)
- e. It is a **reparation** for an offense or injury: a **satisfaction**,
- f. The **reconciliation** of God and humankind through the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ

### 2. Hebrews 9:12-15

**12** He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, thus obtaining<sup>[b]</sup> eternal redemption.

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**13** The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that they are outwardly clean. **14** How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death,<sup>[c]</sup> so that we may serve the living God!

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**15** For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance—now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant.

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
