THE ARAB

Gen 16: Gen 16:11-12

11 And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Behold, thou art with child, and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name Ishmael; because the LORD hath heard thy affliction.

12 And he will be a wild man; his hand will be against every man, and every man's hand against him; and he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren.

WHO ARE THE TWELVE TRIBES OF ISHMAEL TODAY

Now these are the generations of Ishmael, Abraham's son, whom Hagar the Egyptian, Sarah's handmaid, bare unto Abraham: And these are the names of the sons of Ishmael, by their names, according to their generations: the firstborn of Ishmael, **Nebaioth**; and **Kedar**, and **Adbeel**, and **Mibsam**, And **Mishma**, and **Dumah**, and **Massa**, **Hadar**, and **Tema**, **Jetur**, **Naphish**, and **Kedemah**:

These are the sons of Ishmael, and these are their names, by their towns, and by their castles; twelve princes according to their nations.

Genesis 25:12-16

Each with his own nation.

(not including Egypt!)

Although Ismael was the oldest son of Abraham, he was not the son promised, neither was he the seed (of) the Promise!

Galatians 4:22-23 KJV

[22] For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman. [23] But he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise.

Traditionally we are taught the Birthright is the Blessing past down from the Father to the eldest Son.

But Biblically that is not so. As was the case with Ishmael, Esau, and Jacob. Ishmael being the oldest (the Arab), Esau the second oldest 1st born of Isaac (the people identified as Jews) and Jacob the youngest of the three, 2nd born youngest of Isaac (the one still in captivity removed by ship into every nation until the return of Jesus).

JACOB AND HIS CHILDREN RECEIVED THE PROMISE.

THE COVENANT!

According to the word of God Jacob received the blessing (birthright - inheritance - the Land).

Gen 27: 30-33 And it came to pass, as soon as Isaac had made an end of blessing Jacob, and Jacob was yet scarce gone out from the presence of

Isaac his father, that Esau his brother came in from his hunting.
31 And he also had made savoury meat, and brought it unto his father, and
said unto his father, Let my father arise, and eat of his son's venison, that
thy soul may bless me.
32 And Isaac his father said unto him, Who art thou? And he said, I am thy
son, thy firstborn Esau.
33 And Isaac trembled very exceedingly, and said, Who? Where is he that
hath taken venison, and brought it me, and I have eaten of all before thou
camest, and have blessed him? yea, and he shall be blessed

The fight between the individuals in the so-called "Middle-East is about the
Birthright between the descendants of the two oldest sons of Abraham and
Isaac. **ISHMAEL & ESAU!**



But It Belongs To Neither One of Them!
The blessing which is the birthright and the promise (land) belong to Jacob

and his seed. The nation currently in Captivity!

Isaiah 51: 20 Thy sons have fainted, they lie at the head of all the streets,
as a wild bull in a net: they are full of the fury of the LORD, the rebuke of
thy God.



21 Therefore hear now this, thou afflicted, and drunken, but not with wine:

22 Thus saith thy Lord the LORD, and thy God that pleadeth the cause of
his people, Behold, I have taken out of thine hand the cup of trembling,
even the dregs of the cup of my fury; thou shalt no more drink it again:

23 But I will put it into the hand of them that afflict thee; which have said to
thy soul, Bow down, that we may go over: and thou hast laid thy body as
the ground, and as the street, to them that went over.



The Controversy of Zion!

Isaiah 1: 2Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth: for the LORD hath spoken, I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me.

3 The ox knoweth his owner, and the ass his master's crib: but Israel doth not know, my people doth not consider.

4 Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children

that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.

5 Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint.

6 From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores: they have not been closed, neither bound up, neither mollified with ointment.

7 Your country is desolate, your cities are burned with fire: your land, strangers devour it in your presence, and it is desolate, as overthrown by strangers.

(Everyone of the current inhabitants of Jerusalem are strangers to the land!)

Hosea 4: 1 Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land.

2 By swearing, and lying, and killing, and stealing, and committing adultery, they break out, and blood toucheth blood.

3 Therefore shall the land mourn, and every one that dwelleth therein shall languish, with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven; yea, the fishes of the sea also shall be taken away.

5 Therefore shalt thou fall in the day, and the prophet also shall fall with thee in the night, and I will destroy thy mother.

6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to

me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

("Forget thy children"? Who does that sound like?)

Isaiah 34: 1 Come near, ye nations, to hear; and hearken, ye people: let the earth hear, and all that is therein; the world, and all things that come forth of it.

2For the indignation of the LORD is upon all nations, and his fury upon all their armies: he hath utterly destroyed them, he hath delivered them to the slaughter.

3 Their slain also shall be cast out, and their stink shall come up out of their carcases, and the mountains shall be melted with their blood.

4 And all the host of heaven shall be dissolved, and the heavens shall be rolled together as a scroll: and all their host shall fall down, as the leaf falleth off from the vine, and as a falling fig from the fig tree.

5 For my sword shall be bathed in heaven: behold, it shall come down upon Idumea, and upon the people of my curse, to judgment.

(Bozra, Idumea, Edom-so called jews)

6The sword of the LORD is filled with blood, it is made fat with fatness, and with the blood of lambs and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams: for the LORD hath a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughter in the land of Idumea.

8For it is the day of the LORD'S vengeance, and the year of recompences for the controversy of Zion.

(Why?)

Psalms 83: Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God.

2For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head.

3They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones.

("Hidden Ones"?)

4 They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.

5 For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee:

6 The tabernacles of EDOM, and the ISHMAELITES; of MOAB, and the HAGARENES;

7 Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre;

(EDOM-SO CALLED JEWS, ISHMAELITES ARAB, Moab and Ammon-Lot's children-Jordanians...)

12 Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession.

13 O my God, make them like a wheel; as the stubble before the wind.

17 Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to

shame, and perish:

18 That men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth.

(That's right! Jehovah, The one who came in the Father's name "Jesus" will settle that controversy of Zion and restore the land of Jerusalem it's original inhabitants!)

AND THAT HAPPENS TO BE NONE OF THE CURRENT OCCUPIERS OF THE LAND OF ISRAEL!!!!
