Global Experience: Narratives of Ireland

To qualify, students must complete steps 1-4, provide physical evidence for steps 1-4, and a log of hours spent (30 hours required in total):			
Steps	Actions	Details	Evidence
1	Learn about the culture through the Narratives of Ireland course.	Students will sign up for and complete the Narratives of Ireland course through the Institute of Study Abroad Ireland.	Portfolio of coursework including reflective journal, blog or project.
2	Interact with the culture through participation on the course.	Successfully complete all assignments within the course.	Create a journal that summarizes what you learned in the course.
3	Reflect on experience by answering the assigned questions.	See Key Reflection Questions below and the Capstone Guidelines.	A document submitted to Global Scholars Coordinator answering the Key Reflection Questions below
4	Present Capstone	Design a product (for example: powerpoint, video, prezi, website, blog, ePortfolio, etc) which includes summary of experience and critical reflection using Step 3	A presentation which critically reflects on the learning experience. Approximately 15 minutes.

Key Reflection Questions

1. How did your perceptions of Irish culture change after you completed the course?

2. How do you see your experience influencing your future life - academically, professionally, personally?
3. Discuss a challenge you faced completing this course and how you dealt with it. What did you learn as a result of facing this challenge?
