



Reminders:

- School starts at 9:30. That means kids in seats and ready to learn! Please help your kids build the lifeskill of being on time. School ends at 4pm. If your student attends R.O.C.K., they can arrive as early as 8 and be picked up as late as 6pm.
- NO PERSONAL ELECTRONICS at school. At any time other than lunch, they are "off and away." Phones out will be confiscated by staff and multiple issues with electronics will result in a phone contract and a call home.
- Lunch is free for all SFUSD students, and any student may bring a lunch from home. Food cannot be ordered and delivered to campus (no Uber Eats, Door Dash, etc).
- Forms needed.....Multipurpose Family Income Form
 - Parents who have not fill out the Multipurpose Family Income Form please go on schoolcafe.com to fill it online. Or you can request a paper form from school.
- Nurse Michelle says... Health requirements for school!
 - ALL 7th grade students must bring proof of their TDAP booster shot. Students will not be able to continue to attend school without it. If you are unsure if you have already completed this requirement, please call the school or email Nurse Michelle (raitm@sfusd.edu)
 - If your student is on a "catch-up" schedule for your vaccines—meaning they were still getting their polio, hepatitis B, varicella, and other vaccines last year-you must continue to provide proof that your student is getting the required vaccines or they will not be allowed to continue to attend school.

Immunization updates

For Families of students to SFUSD:

Please be sure to bring proof of a negative TB test and a record of all the shots your child has received to the front office as soon as possible. State law and district policy say that your child is NOT able to start school without these records on file. We do not want your child to miss any school because of this. If you have questions or need help finding a place to get these requirements met, please call the school directly and we will assist you.

For Families of 7th grade students:

All students entering 7th grade must provide proof of receiving their TDAP booster shot. If you have not already done so, please submit the documentation as soon as possible.

Update on COVID Safety Procedures

There are no new updates to our COVID safety policies and procedures for the upcoming school year. Masks will be strongly recommended, but not required for students or staff at VVMS, per SFUSD and public health guidelines. If your student is sick or tests positive for COVID 19, please contact the front office at **415-469-4590** immediately. Do NOT contact any of your child's teachers. It is important we are aware of any COVID-related illness for tracking and attendance purposes.

SFUSD Family Portal (ParentVUE) account

If you have not already done so, please activate your SFUSD Family Portal (ParentVUE) account. ParentVUE accounts are easy to set up, and they are the best way for you to stay connected to what's going on in the district and in your student's learning, including:

• Helping your student engage in learning, by accessing their login information to SFUSD digital learning platforms.

- Seeing important academic information, including your student's participation in learning, assignments, grades, and report cards.
- Receiving timely communications from your school and from SFUSD, by updating your phone number, email address, and mailing address.

Student/Family Handbook

What to Wear

VVMS does not have a school uniform policy, and follows a modified version of the SFUSD dress code. All students must wear a top and a bottom. Undergarments may not be visible, and clothing or other items with inappropriate language or images are not allowed. Additionally, clothing should cover the body. For example, very short crop tops or tops that look like swimwear are not allowed.

Food Service

Students may bring food from home or have lunch provided by the school. Lunch is free for all VVMS students. In accordance with the SFUSD nutrition policy, please do not send your student to school with soda, candy, gum, or fast food. We **do not** have microwaves available for student use, and food ordering and delivery to campus **is not permitted.** If you are bringing lunch to your child, please bring it to the office during lunch hours only, and have the office call for your child to come get it.

New Student/Newcomer Vaccine Requirements

ALL students new to SFUSD must have proof of a negative tuberculosis test before starting school. They may complete a risk assessment if appropriate. For students who were on a "catch-up" schedule last year, or have not completed all their required vaccines, they must continue to receive their vaccines to remain in school.
