- f. Which other people help doctors to diagnose patients? (1 point)
- g. What is physically taken from patients in order to be evaluated? (1 point)
- h. What are two sources of medical information used to determine what an illness is? (1 point)
- i. What is one similarity mentioned between Chinese and Western doctors?(1 point)
