Call to Order

Old Business

- **Section 2.01.** changed "is a high school graduate " to " is 18 years of age or older, and is not currently a high school student"
- Section 2.03. changed "A qualified eligible wrestler shall have a sponsoring member by March 1st of each year to be eligible for off-season assistance that year." to "A qualified eligible wrestler must have a sponsoring member approved by coaches and the board of officers to be eligible for off-season assistance that year."
- **Section 3.02.** changed "shall be to follow the Athletics Boosters meetings, second monday of each month" to "shall be held on the second Thursday of each month."
- **Section 3.06.** changed agenda "call to order, old business, new business, Reports of Officers, Fundraising, other business, Adjournment" to "Call to Order,Old Business, Reports of Officers, New Business, Fundraising, Additions to the Agenda, Upcoming Events, Adjournment"
- Section 4.06. changed "At the annual membership meeting" to "During the May monthly meeting, officers" and changed "Vote will be conducted via google form" to "The vote will take place during the July monthly meeting or any open mats held in the 2nd week of July. An absentee ballot will be available upon request."
- Section 4.08. added Vacancies in the Board of Officers: Whenever a position on the Board becomes vacant due to death, resignation, or any other reason, the President will appoint a new officer to fill the vacancy. If the President does not make an appointment within 30 days of being notified of the vacancy, the remaining officers will fill the vacancy by a majority vote at a regular or specially Board meeting. The person appointed to fill the vacancy will serve for the remaining term of his or her predecessor.

Section 4.09

Removal of an Officer:

An officer may be removed from the board due to excessive absences, which is defined as more than 2 unexcused absences from board meetings in a year. Additionally, an officer may be removed for other reasons, with or without cause, by a two-thirds vote of the remaining of the remaining officers in a specially called meeting for that purpose. At such a meeting, the vacancy will be filled as outlined in Section 4.08.
