## RESPONSIBILITY FOR CURRENT REGULATIONS

The Minister for Local Government/OLG say they don't make the rules, that they change the regs based on NSWEC advice, that is NSWEC that decide the policy settings around the conduct of elections.

- 1. Why, when and who decided to implement the minimum preference requirements that are in the forms of ballot paper in Schedule 11 of the regulations?
- 2. Was there any public discussion about these minimum preference rules at the time that we can look at?

A gazette notice or question time dixer - anything like that? We're trying to get an understanding of what was intended and the rationale, as well as whether there is a reasonable expectation for people to know that these rules work the way they do.

- **3a) When this decision was made -** or if it was not overtly made but rather is a legacy of a different time, in any of the review of the legislation and regulations that OLG tells us happens in the lead up to each election was there a consideration given to the resultant high informality rate and the consequences of that to electoral result?
- 3b) if yes, did that consideration specifically include impact on vulnerable populations?
- 4) Who is the ultimate decision maker for how those regulations should be interpreted and applied?
- 5) Is there a policy or guideline on how the savings provisions are to be applied in local government elections that explains the NSWEC's practice that we can access?
- 6) Has there been any court proceedings or ruling in relation to application of savings provisions in local government elections that has informed or dictated current practices?
- 7) As part of the current parliamentary inquiry into trust in the electoral process, or through any other process, has the NSWEC previously advised that reform is needed on these requirements for local government elections to reduce the informality rate?

## APPLICATION OF SAVING PROVISIONS AND OTHER ISSUES IN THE VOTE DATA

We're still working through the vote data file but it would be very helpful if we could get a better understanding of what we are looking at.

- 8. Can you advise what specifically the X and \ symbols in the voter data files refer to?
- 9. How and for how long do you keep the physical ballots?
- 10. We understand that two different people do the data entry and there is a reconciliation process, but we have found some examples of likely data entry errors in the MPSC vote data. Can you advise if there is any part of the process where possible coding errors are reviewed by a returning officer or other person physically inspecting the ballot paper? To assist, here's a few examples:

## **TOOMELAH**

We still haven't figured out what exactly went wrong in Toomelah. Previous results from there had next to no informal votes, it's one of the things that makes this event more odd.

13a. It is our understanding that Toomelah normally has a booth for state elections, but not always for local or federal elections, and didn't have a booth in the 2021 local government election. Why was the decision made to hold a booth there this time, and who made that decision?

- 13b. Given there was no Toomelah booth in 2021, and recent elections were state elections with optional preferences (or Land Council elections which are generally just vote 1), was there any communication or education undertaken to ensure that locals there understood that the requirements to vote formally were different for a local government election?
- 14. The Moree Plains Shire Council Director of Legal and Governance has recommended that MPSC conduct the more expensive by-election rather than a countback, which we understand is driven by the concerns around the electoral irregularities. **Did MPSC consult with NSWEC on these issues between the election and making this recommendation?**
- 15. Was there any other booth in any other LGA that experienced the same near complete vote failure in 2024 as Toomelah?
- **16.** Locals have said they were given no verbal instructions, which aligns with your previous answer that booth staff said no one asked for further instructions. **Is it normal practice for booth staff not to explain the formality requirements verbally?**
- 17. Is there a script or similar guidance given in training to booth workers on what they must do and say when issuing a ballot paper to a voter? We would appreciate it if we could see a copy if possible.
- 18. Did Council, or anyone from Toomelah, formally raise concerns with NSWEC prior to the declaration of the MPSC result?
