

HOW TO ACCESS YOUR ACT SCORES ONLINE

Your ACT score from the State testing at LHS is available online. In order to access this score, you must connect it to a new or existing online account. This must be done in order to view your ACT scores online and to send them electronically to colleges.

Two options:

1. You have NEVER created an online ACT account and did NOT take the ACT prior to the March testing
 - a. Go to actstudent.org
 - b. Click on “sign up” in Student Web Account box
 - c. Click “create account”
 - d. “Have you registered for the ACT before?” - click “NO”
 - e. “Have you taken the ACT before?” - click “YES”
 - f. Enter the requested information
 - g. Enter your social security number or the ID number found at the top of your paper ACT score report
 - h. A message will indicate that your scores have been found and have been connected to this new online account
 - i. If your scores are NOT found, go through the process again to be sure you entered everything correctly, as your data must exactly match the data on your score report. If your scores are still not found, call the ACT office for help (see below).

2. You created an online ACT account and took the ACT on your own prior to the March test at LHS **OR** you did NOT take the ACT before the March test but already created an account
 - a. You must call the ACT Help Desk to have your scores connected. You cannot connect your scores online. Do NOT create a new separate account!
 - b. Tell the representative that you took the ACT in March at your high school through a mandated state testing program and that you had already created an online ACT account.
 - c. Ask them to connect your March scores to your already created ACT account
