

PRIVACY POLICY

(Last Updated and Effective date : 16 June 2023)

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your Personal Data (as defined below) and how we will treat it. This Privacy Policy applies to Inverse.AI's apps. This Privacy Policy explains how we, and affiliated companies (collectively, "Inverse.AI" or "we", "us", "our") collect, use, secure, and/or disclose end users' ("you" or "your").

INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW

While using our Services, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to identify you ("Personal Data"). - **Device Information**

- **Usage Information**

We collect information automatically about your activity through our Services, for example, features you have used, in-app purchase history, subscriptions, total units you have purchased, total units you have used, and number of files you have saved.

- **Other information**

We may collect upon your permission about your photo library and other cloud directories.

- **Information we obtain from third parties**

We may receive information about you from our analytic service providers with data they collect through our Services in accordance with their own privacy policies. A list of the third parties that operate in our Services can be found in [APPENDIX B](#) below.

WHAT WE WILL USE AND WHY

We have set out below a description of the ways in which we use your information:

- We use your device ID to recognize you and personalize our app for you.
- We check your internet connectivity to fetch the required data to set up the app for you.
- We will use your Device storage for saving Data the app produced.
- We will use your storage to track your usage and In-App-Purchase activities.
- We will use your mobile data or wifi to push your usage information to our server to delivery personalized assets and content to you.
- To serve personalized advertisements in our Services using third-party advertising networks.

STORAGE, DISCLOSURE, TRANSFER, AND SHARING OF YOUR INFORMATION

- **Storage**
We use your device storage to save edited images, imported files from the cloud, and information regarding In-app-purchases.
- **Share with our service providers and partners**
