Mission of the group?

What specifically are members requested to do? The congregation members are requested to donate money or volunteer with the Share the Plate recommended organization. The STP committee members oversee the selection of the organizations that will receive a donation.

GROUP CHARTER

How many people can participate in your group? The committee membership consists of six people who make a two-year commitment each. Three people rotate off per year. One serves as the “lead” or “chair” for the year to assure communication with the Office and outside questions.

Are you currently seeking new members? Yes. We are currently down to just 3 members and need 3 more!

If not, when might you be seeking new members? The committee seeks three new committee members in the spring.

How often do you meet? We meet approximately once a quarter to identify recipients for Share the Plate.

Do you typically meet in the evenings, daytime, using Zoom, or other, i.e., combination of all? Meeting dates and times are up to the committee and we meet both in person and virtually (by zoom) depending on committee availability.

Do you meet year round? Fall to spring? Other? We meet once a quarter. Our next meeting is scheduled for September 28 after Sunday’s service.

Is there a set term to participate in this group? Committee members serve a two-year term.
