Introduction: A Call to Gospel Unity

In a world hungering for the truth and love of Christ, [Missions:Together \(M:T\)](#) stands as a collective and community of possibilities & hope uniting Christians, pastors, leaders, churches, ministries, networks, resources and faith-based organizations in a shared vision to joyfully advance the gospel and the kingdom of God. (Eph 4:3-6)

[Missions:Together \(M:T\)](#) seeks to coalesce believers and leverage the power of unity into Kingdom expansion. This unity is a divine manifestation of the gospel's power among believers. It's an expression of the loving harmony within the Trinity, transcends differences, and showcases God's ability to bring diversity of believers into worship and [missions: together](#). We therefore seek to leverage this power to live outward-facing lives, prioritizing the Great Commission. (Jn 17:21-23)

Therefore, M:T exists to:

- Be a mission collaborative driven by Church leaders from the Triangle to invite people to their place of mission grounded in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20):
- To be *in competition with no one and complementary to, supportive of, any work dedicated to proclamation of salvation in Christ alone by grace and through faith alone for His glory alone* (Ephesians 2:8-10);
- Create, deliver, and promote resources, services and events to embrace networking with and equipping the Body of Christ in the Triangle; (I Pet 4:10-11)
- Rely on the Holy Spirit through vibrant prayer as a heavenly expedient for the pursuit of the Great Commission. (Acts 1:8)

1. A Call to Action: Together, We Can

- 1.1. Invite the Church to make Christ known and worshiped as we recognize the Church as the vehicle through which the knowledge of God's glory is spread throughout the earth. (Mt 28:18-20; Rom 10:14-15; Acts: 20:28)
- 1.2. Embrace unique ministries within our churches as well as parachurch ministries to accomplish collectively what we cannot do alone. (John 17: 21-23)

- 1.3. See a generation of bold, resilient and courageous outward-facing Christians pursuing the transformation of individuals, entire cultures and communities, and remove the stigma surrounding evangelism. (Matthew 5:14-16)

2. What Is Missions?

The Mission is the manifestation of *"Thy Kingdom Come."* It is the work, empowered by the Holy Spirit, in obedience to the Great Commission, to faithfully proclaim the reign and worship of Jesus Christ to all the earth so that those who have yet to entrust themselves to His sovereign care become his disciples. (Acts 13:47)

 - Collaboration multiplies the effectiveness of mission. (Phil 1:27; 1 Cor 3:8-9)

 - Prayer is the primary mobilization and sending strategy and where meetings stretch into hours, filled with fervor and faith.
