COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will be introduced to the academic study of the historical books of the Old Testament: Joshua, Judges, 1 and 2 Samuel, 1 and 2 Kings, 1 and 2 Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah, and Esther. Emphasis will be given to the various critical issues related to the composition, reception, and interpretation of the books. Additionally, students will study the art of history writing and the interpretation of selected texts. *Prerequisites: Old Testament Survey and Hermeneutics.*

학생들은 구약성서 역사서에 대한 학문적 연구를 소개 받게 된다: 여호수아, 사사기, 사무엘상하, 열왕기상하, 역대상하, 에스라, 느헤미야, 그리고 에스서. 각 책의 편찬, 수용, 그리고 해석과 관련된 다양한 비판 (비교) 적 쟁점들을 중점적으로 다룬다. 또한, 역사 서술 기법과 선택된 본문의 해석에 대해서도 학습한다.

COURSE STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the completion of this course, each student will be able to:

1. Identify the significant characters, themes, and historical events in the historical books.
2. Identify and critically evaluate the introductory issues of the historical books, including authorship, historicity, and dating.
3. Identify the basic literary features of the historical books.
4. Apply the truths of the historical books to one's personal life.

이 과목을 마치면 각 학생은:

1. 역사서에 나오는 중요한 등장인물들, 주제들과 역사적 사건들을 식별한다
2. 역사서의 서론적 문제들, 즉 저자, 역사성, 연대등을 파악하고 비판적으로 평가한다
3. 역사서의 기본적인 문학적 특징을 파악한다
4. 역사서의 진실을 개인의 삶에 적용한다

COURSE TEACHING METHDOLOGY

This course is primarily lecture-driven, though students are required to participate via regular interaction with the lecture materials as well as individual presentations and other learning assignments.

COURSE EVALUATION

The student's grade will be computed as follows:

Pre-Course Project - Students will complete one (1) pre-course project and bring it to the first course meet. The pre-course project comprises 20% of the final course grade.

학생들은 강의 전 프로젝트를 끝내어 강의 첫 시간까지 제출하여야 한다. 강의 전 프로젝트는 전체 성적의 20%를 차지한다.

Participation - Students will actively participate in class discussions. Those who cannot participate in class discussions shall arrange time with the instructor to fulfill this requirement. The participation comprises 20% of the final course grade.

학생들은 강의시간 토론에 적극적으로 참여하여야 한다. 사정으로 강의토론에 참여하지 못하는 학생들은 교수와 개별적으로 시간을 정해 토론에 참여한다. 참여는 전체 성적의 20%를 차지한다.

Quizzes - Students will take five (5) quizzes over daily reading assignments. Students will be responsible for completing daily reading assignments (see schedule below). These quizzes comprise 20% of the final grade.

학생들은 총 다섯 (5) 번의 퀴즈를 치르게 된다. 학생들은 매일 정해진 독서 과제물을 하여야 한다 (아래 스케줄 참조). 퀴즈는 전체 성적의 20%를 차지한다.

Exam - Students will take one (1) final exam and submit it before the due date. The final exam comprises 20% of the final course grade.

Research Project - Students will write one (1) research project and submit it before the due date. Students will choose one topic from the list of topics suggested by the instructor. The research project comprises 20% of the final course grade.
