

Subject: Strip SAVE Act language from the NDAA

Dear Senator,

I am writing as your constituent to urge you to strip the SAVE Act language out of the NDAA and oppose any final bill that includes it.

This is zombie legislation. It keeps coming back in new forms, and now it is being slipped into a must-pass defense bill in an effort to force through voting restrictions that do not belong there. Eligible Americans should never have to fight harder just to register and vote.

The SAVE Act would create unnecessary barriers for voters, including Americans abroad, voters who have changed their name, and others who may not have easy access to the documents this bill would require. That is not election security. It is voter suppression dressed up as reform.

I urge you to remove this language from the NDAA and reject any attempt to revive this zombie legislation. Please stand up for voting rights, voter access, and fair elections.
