

Friends for Life Pinwheel/Tower Card Tutorial

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Friends for Life Bundle (163365) or stamp set (163359)
- **Card Stock** – Melon Mambo(115320); Crushed Curry (131199); Pumpkin Pie (105117); Basic White Thick(159229; Berry Burst (144243); Melon Mambo (115320); Full of Life 6x6 Designer Series Paper (163357)
- **Stamp Pads** – Melon Mambo (147051)
- **Tools** – Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Friends for Life Dies (163364)l Paper Trimmer (152392); Paper Snips (103579)
- **Misc.** – Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813); Stampin; Dimensionals (104430); Iridescent Faceted Gems (163368); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Multipurpose Glue (110755)

Measurements:

- Melon Mambo – 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " scored at 1", 2", 3" and 4"; 3 at 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Full of Life DSP – 7 at 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" (I used 7 different pieces but you can use all the same)
- Basic White Thick – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4"
- Melon Mambo, Pumpkin Pie, Crushed Curry scraps for cutting hearts and leaves.

Instructions:

1. Using Stampin' Seal Adhesive, adhere one piece of the DSP to panel on the scored piece of Melon Mambo cardstock making sure it is on the side where the tube will fold and adhere.



2. Using Stampin' Seal Adhesive, adhere the other six pieces of DSP to both sides of the three 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " panels that are cut. Attach panels to the other three





3. Stamp sentiment using Melon Mambo Ink onto Basic White Thick cardstock and cut with Paper Snips and attach with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Stamp the white piece of cardstock using Melon Mambo ink. Ink once, stamp three times.
5. Stamp HI in a circle (if desired) with Melon Mambo Ink.
6. Using scraps cut the hearts and leaves for decorating. Adhere with Mini Glue Dots, Multipurpos Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.

Option:

- Decorate panels if desired.
- Add photos or favorite quotes to panels if desired.
- Use cardstock and emboss instead of DSP.
- Use your imagination.
