ABSTRACT

[Merriweather 14, bold, centered]

The body of the abstract should be typed in normal 10-point Merriweather in a single paragraph, immediately following the heading. The text should be set to 1 line spacing. Abstract should stand alone, means that no citation in abstract. Abstract should tell the prospective reader what you did and highlight the key findings. Avoid using technical jargon and uncommon abbreviations. You must be accurate, brief, clear and specific. On the abstract, explicitly write in bold: introduction, gap in literature or discrepancies between theories and practices, purpose of study, method, main findings and conclusion. The abstract should be written in 150-250 words.

Keywords: The author must provide 3-5 keywords which can reflect conducted topic generally. (Keywords are written italic) *[Merriweather 10, bold, with a colon]*
