OFFICIAL RULES

- These rules (the “Official Rules”) govern the various contest activities conducted as part of the Intel **DevMesh Project Contest** (the “Contest”) and set out the terms and conditions between Intel Corporation and its affiliates (“Intel”, “Organizer” or “us/we”) and each participant (“participant” or “you”). A submission to the Contest constitutes your acceptance of the Official Rules.
- The Contest requires participants to create a project in accordance with the Entry Requirements set out below and at devmesh.intel.com. You will be asked to enter contact information so that Intel can contact you for Contest announcements and prize distribution. Your contact information will be treated in accordance with Intel’s privacy policy which you can review at http://www.intel.com/sites/corporate/privacy.htm?iid=homepage+fr_privacy.
- The Organizer is offering the Contest and will award prizes based on the results of judging all valid entries against the criteria established in the Official Rules.

Entry Requirements:

- Submit your entry by creating a project at Intel DevMesh (devmesh.intel.com)

- Entries must be received during the Contest Period.

Required with entry:

- All software dependencies are required to run your application.
- All projects must run on Intel DevCloud
- All software must be in source form and properly licensed with a permissive license allowing Intel to use it later in teaching presentations.
- A short presentation explaining the function of the code and what you did to optimize the execution.

Contest Entry Limit:

- The entrant will receive **One (1) Entry** for the contest, for each activity. Participants submitting multiple entries will be disqualified.

Eligibility:

- The contest is open to residents of Australia, India, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, New Zealand, the Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Thailand and Vietnam.



- The participant needs to be at least eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry; and at least the age of majority in their province or territory of residence at the time of entry.
- Employees, officers and representatives (and members of their immediate families and those living in the same household of each) of Intel Corporation, its parents, subsidiaries and affiliated companies, advertising and promotion agencies and any company involved in the design, execution, production or judging of this promotion (“Contest entities”) are ineligible.

- **Finality of Decisions:** By participating in the Contest, participants agree to be bound by the Official Rules and the decisions of the Organizer /independent judges, which are final in all respects and not subject to appeal. The organizer reserves the right permanently to disqualify from these Contest any participant it believes has violated the Official Rules.
- **Ownership and Publicity:** Organizer does not claim ownership of your submission to the Contest; but by submitting an entry, you are granting Organizer and its affiliated companies the following worldwide, non-exclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, unconditional, fully paid-up rights: (1) to make, have made, use, copy, reproduce, modify, and create derivative works of the contributions, (2) to publicly perform or display, import, broadcast, transmit, distribute (directly and indirectly through multiple tiers), license, offer to sell and sell, rent, lease, or lend copies of the contributions (and derivative works thereof), (3) to sublicense to third parties the foregoing rights, including the right to sublicense to further third parties, and (4) to publish your name or alias in connection with this Contest and your contributions. Participants understand and agree that their submissions may be posted and publicly viewable. By providing a submission, you grant Organizer the right, except where prohibited by law, to use your name for promotional purposes in



promoting or publicizing the Contest. The organizer, however, does not have any obligation to use the winning Entries for any purpose.

- **Participant Warrants:** By submitting an entry, you warrant that you:
 - own or otherwise have all rights necessary for the submission including any and all IP rights and you do not disclose any information which would constitute a violation of a confidentiality obligation;
 - your submission does not contain any viruses, worms, spyware, or other components or instructions that are malicious, deceptive, or designed to limit or harm the functionality of a computer; and
 - Your contributions are not subject to license terms that require any software or documentation incorporating or being derived from your contributions to be licensed to others.
- **No Monetary Compensation:** Apart from prizes offered as part of the Contest, no monetary compensation will be paid for any of your Contest submissions. Organizer is not responsible for Contest entries not received due to lost, failed, delayed or interrupted connections or miscommunications, or other electronic malfunctions. Intel is not responsible for incorrect or inaccurate entry information, whether caused by you or any other persons or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest.
- **Lost Or Misdirected Entries:** Organizer and/or Contest Entities are not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, undeliverable or incomplete Entries, whether due to system errors or failures, faulty transmissions or other telecommunications malfunctions, Entries not received resulting from any hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections, failed, incomplete or garbled computer or telephone transmissions, typographical or system errors and failures, faulty transmissions, technical malfunctions, or otherwise.
