



Headrest Cage Mount Kit and Utility Post Add-on

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION GUIDE

Thank you for choosing [Cruzbike](#) and the Headrest Cage Mount Kit. This kit installs easily on our performance bike headrests (the V20 and S40 and older Vendetta and Silvio models with headrests) for easy, aerodynamic access to bottles while cycling. This guide includes instructions for assembling and installing the Headrest Cage Mount Kit, installing water bottle cages and installing the Utility Post Add-on.

Tools Required

Number 5 allen wrench

Number 4 allen wrench

Number 3 allen wrench

Note: [Headrest Cage Mount Kit](#), [Bottle Cages](#) and [Utility Post Add-on](#) are sold separately.

Headrest Cage Mount Kit Assembly and Installation

Remove cushion from installed stock headrest.

Note: Some of the older V and S headrest cushion covers slide on like a sock and do not have velcro to hold it onto the headrest tubes. If this describes your headrest cushion, please contact us at support@cruzbike.com for a replacement.

Next, remove back of Headrest Cage Mount Kit clamp with number 5 allen wrench (**first image below**). Clamp Headrest Cage Mount around headrest tubes and tighten with number 5 allen wrench (**second image below**).



Adjust angle of the water bottle cage mounts by loosening the center bolt where the cage mounts attach to the clamp using a number 4 allen wrench. Once set to desired angle, re-tighten center bolt (**image below**).



Bottle Cage Installation

Use included bolts and a number 3 allen wrench to attach the water bottle cages to the water bottle cage mount (**first and second images below**). It is not necessary to install a nut (**third image below**).



Utility Post Add-on Installation

Install the Utility Post Add-on by slotting the tab between the water bottle cage mount and the water bottle cage using the included bolt (**first image below**). Tighten with a number 3 allen wrench. The Utility Post Add-on can also be installed directly to the cage mount if you are not using water bottle cages (**second image below**). Again, no nut is necessary.
