I welcome you to blog with me here at I Enjoy Music.

If you have blogged before, great. If you have never blogged before, that's cool too. I would like other people to contribute their vibes to the site!

What I am looking for: writing about music that you care very deeply about, from any time period, no artist too big or too small; writing in your own weird and groovy voice; writing that is personal in any particular way; writing that you are willing to allow to be edited by moi to reach basic spelling and grammar correctness; writing from people from all walks of life and all music/writing experience (it is okay if you have never written for a blog before in your life!); writing in unconventional formats; writing about not just music itself, but music labor, music technology, music commerce, music community.

Examples: local scene reports, live show recaps, personal musical obsessions that make you go "Why is no one talking about this??", Music Moots™ (that's where you ask a friend to recommend a song to listen to, and then write about it), or of course, good old fashioned interviews with music folks.

What I am *not* **looking for**: album or song reviews, straight-up news, track or video premieres (not yet anyway), rehashed press releases, giving music a score or ranking.

What I would most like to publish: any kind of writing that celebrates musical connections and musical interactions, writing that proves music doesn't exist in a vacuum, but is rather created by people, and experienced by people, and no one experiences it exactly the same way. ["Sweet Disposition" by The Temper Trap starts playing for some reason]

Payment: I'm paying \$50/post. For transparency's sake, I will say that I Enjoy Music is not currently a robust money-making enterprise (though I am starting to make some \$ with merch!), so writing fees are coming out of my own pocket for the time being; in the startup world, I believe this would be called 'bootstrapping.' But I can publish as many as 4 guest posts a month. Also I am aware that online payments sometimes deal in sensitive info (like legal names that might not match your actual name!)—I promise to handle such info with discretion.

How this will work

- Email me at ienjoymusicblog@gmail.com with the subject line: WRITING PITCH
- Introduce yourself, share any relevant links (published writing if you have it, a link to your own blog, etc.) and share a little bit about your idea
 - Example: "I would like to write a blog about why I love songs that have the word AND as the first word in the lyrics"
- If your pitch has been accepted:
 - When your blog is ready, share a google doc with edit access to ienjoymusicblog [at] gmail [dot] com. The doc should contain:
 - The text of your blog, incl. a suggested title for it
 - Your name (or your nom de blog) and your pronouns
 - A short bio written in the third person, including any links to your social media profiles in case you want those in there
