4. Lope on the left lead past the center cone and stop and perform a right rollback.
5. Lope on the right lead around the end of the arena past the center cone and stop. Back to center or at least 10 feet.
6. Spin two spins to the left. Hesitate.
7. Spin two spins to the right.
