What you can expect from me

Generally, I will deliver your commission in stages for you to look at and approve. I will do my best to make sure I get every important detail down that you point out. Anything that is left out will be up to my interpretation. I will be honest in letting you, the client, know if I feel unable to meet your expectations. Should that happen, I will show you what I have and we can work together from there or set up an alternative. I want to be able to deliver my best work possible to you.

As an artist, I reserve the right to deny a commission request. In addition, I reserve the right to upload commissioned artwork I've done to an online gallery (typically FurAffinity) or any of my social media. You are also free to upload your commission wherever you like. However, should you wish to keep your commission private, I will respect your decision and avoid uploading your commissioned artwork online. Please let me know as soon as possible if you wish to keep it private. Your artwork will only appear in our private messages and anywhere else you decide to upload it.

By commissioning me, you agree that your commission will be for personal use only, and that my commissioned work is **not** to be used for commercial purposes unless agreed upon with me prior to the order of your commission.

Availability: I will usually continue to accept commission requests on a first come first served basis with no fixed limit. Whenever I cannot accept anymore or I am open for a new batch of commissions, I will announce it on my <u>Twitter</u> so please keep an eye out for those announcements. A new batch of commissions will start once the previous batch of commissions are finished.

Turnaround time: You can expect your commission to take anywhere between 2-4 weeks or less depending on how busy I am with other commissions and personal life. Larger commissions can typically be expected to take more than 4 weeks. However, no matter how busy I am, I always make an effort to finish all commissions in under 2 months. Otherwise, I will let you know if I need to put a current WIP on hold beyond 2 months.

Please have the following ready, so as to make the commission process go by smoothly:

- Reference sheet (reference sheet is preferred, but if unavailable you may provide other artwork that you have of your character, or a thorough description of your character)
- Reference images (for themes/examples you wish for me to draw from in your commission)
 - You may also provide a description of what you want if there are no images to your liking
- Your Commission "Type" (see Prices & Payment section below)
- Your PayPal address, as I only accept payment via PayPal

What I will/won't draw

I will draw:

- SFW
- Edgy, wholesome, or fan art
- Ferals/Anthros of any animal species
- Portraits, icons
- Multiple characters in one piece (up to and including 5)
- Humans

I won't draw:

- NSFW
- Political & hateful themes
- Kinks & fetish art
- Environmental & scenic backgrounds
- Reference sheets



Ink - Full body (\$60)

- Smaller details may not always be clearly drawn out depending on how intricate they are
- Small splashes of colour may be used to accent the piece (applies to all ink-style commission types)



Colour - Head shot (\$50)

- Most/all colours on ref sheets are used
- Smaller details are drawn out
- Background is a simple block/shape/wash or abstract
- Made to resemble traditional ink & watercolour drawing



Colour - Half body (\$70)



Colour - Full body (\$90)

 Smaller details may not always be drawn out depending on how intricate they are



Illustration - (\$120+)

- Smaller details may not always be drawn out depending on how intricate they are
- Only offered in Colour
- Exact price is to be discussed depending on the complexity of the scene and composition
 - Scene and composition will be discussed and brainstormed before payment





- Extra characters (whether they be the same or of a different character) come with an additional 50% of base price, per character
 - Eg. adding one extra character in Full body + Colour will cost an additional
 \$45. (\$90 base + \$45 one extra character = \$135 total)
- Backgrounds (simple or left blank) for Ink and Colour commission types come at no extra cost
- No complexity fee for wings, markings, etc.

<u>Refunds</u> - You are entitled to 50% of the total value up to and including whenever the Clean Sketch is delivered to you. **Once you approve of the Clean Sketch, I will move onto line work from which no refunds can be made.**

WIPs and Edits

When I work, I typically deliver WIPs in 3 stages:

[1] Rough Sketch - I will create a selection of rough poses to choose from. If you already have an idea you want in particular, whether it be before or after seeing the Rough Sketch, please let me know and I will do my best to get your idea down on paper!

 If you already have a specific idea in mind, I will skip this stage and go straight to clean sketches, and draw a few variations for us to choose from

[2] Clean Sketch - Once a rough sketch has been decided, I will clean it up and add a few details as necessary. If you feel you want to see previous Rough Sketches cleaned up, please let me know as soon as possible. The extra clean sketches will come at no additional cost.

[3] Line work & Colour - Once the Clean Sketch is approved, I will move on to line art and/or colours. At this point, no major changes can be made (pose, limb placement, etc.). Minor changes can still be made (eg. shifts in colour). Please be sure any must-have details have been specified, as at this point I will have artistic freedom to interpret as I wish.

If you wish to see a current WIP at any point in the commission process, feel free to let me know and I will send it your way. You may also keep and use any WIP pictures I send you, including editing them yourself, as long as you give credit where it's due.

After your commission...

Do note that at any point in the future, if you ever notice any small details in your commissioned image that bothers you, you can always send me a message about it and I'll see what I can do to fix it for you at no extra charge.
