General Information

The course "Listen English with Ease" offers an integrated study of the English language and culture through authentic audio and video materials. It aims to effectively develop foreign language communicative competence, with a primary emphasis on enhancing English listening skills. Graduates of higher education will acquire:

- Proficiency in comprehending foreign speech within the context of communicative scenarios.
- Proficiency in adapting one's speech patterns in line with an understanding of the socio-cultural dynamics of English-speaking countries.
- A disposition towards tolerance, respecting the freedoms and values of others.

The course caters to undergraduate students with a minimum English proficiency level of A2.

Course Objectives

The course "Listen English with Ease" aims to systematically cultivate foreign language communicative competence, with a specific focus on enhancing listening skills.

Upon successful completion of the course, students will be proficient in:

- Engaging in spoken English communication on the topics covered.
- Broadening their general and socio-cultural perspectives by exploring various aspects of world culture.
- Enhancing listening and speaking skills, encompassing phonological, lexical, and grammatical components of language competence.

- Employing strategies to effectively absorb phonetic, lexical, and grammatical material based on methodological recommendations.
- Demonstrating the ability to make decisions in challenging and unpredictable situations, necessitating the application of novel approaches, foresight, and creative thinking.
- Recognizing the importance of ongoing learning; engaging in the study, analysis, synthesis, and dissemination of intercultural communication experiences.

Course Outline and Teaching Methodology

The course is taught in the form of face-to-face practical classes (60 hours). Students' independent work involves the use of information resources of the university and the Internet, in particular the UNICOM (60 hours). The teacher will use communicative and interactive teaching methods.
