→ Land Trust Plan -Review and Q & A (Budget Review)

- ◆ We had carryover, \$2,154. We weren't expecting that. We try to spend as much possible. We have to hold back money in the budget for insurance or

retirement and sometimes that doesn't balance out and why we might have extra money.

- ◆ \$62,000 of the money basically goes to employees. \$5,000 goes towards training such as LETRS K-5. Other money goes towards General supplies and Social emotional items. Right now we're not paying our Social Work or Psychologist out of this money, but once ESSR money we might have to use Land Trust money. Other money goes into software to support reading. The last of the money goes into Chromebook and headphones.
- ◆ Right now we're paying for a .5 of FTE for Morales and the other half is paid by land trust land trust and TSSA money. We have two paras that are being paid with Land Trust money (\$1610.86).

→ Continuous School Improvement Plan 2022-2023

- ◆ We are a TSI school that needs to focus on MLL's and SPED. We did show improvement on MLL's last year by looking at the WIDA data. Third grade showed great test scores last year. Not only do we need to focus on how 3rd grade and up but also how students are doing in the lower grades so they are ready once they get to 3rd grade.
- ◆ We might need to do trainings for parents so they know how to help at home.
- ◆ Teachers were able to learn about WIDA scores and how to look at the individual areas (i.e. speaking, writing, listening, reading) and how to help students improve.
- ◆ There are three areas that will change this year Academic, Behaviors, and Teacher Related.
