Minimum 2.0 GPA (Include a copy of most recent report card)</li><li>4. Accepted and attending a college, university or vocational institution in the <b>State of Michigan</b></li><li>5. Have a MINIMUM of 4 hours of PTSA service, documented by a PTSA board member or on the student's service forms over their high school career. For example, assisting at Open House, Honors Night, Parent Teacher Conferences, schedule distributions or other PTSA events.</li></ol>

**Applicants must attach the following items to this application:**

1. Two (2) letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach or community service advisor, each in a sealed envelope
2. Copy of most recent report card
3. A one page typed essay (Size 12 font, double-space) on the following topic.
