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GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

The theses of the report are submitted in the Microsoft Word editor (Times New Roman, size – 14, line spacing – 1.5, paragraph indent – 1 cm, all edges – 2 cm) in .doc format without hyphenation in words. The last name and initials are typed in the right upper corner. The title of the theses is put in capital letters, in bold, with centre alignment symmetrically to the text. The main text is put one line after the title. The sources cited in the References should be given in the alphabetical order; references in the text should be made in square brackets, indicating the source number and page: [1, p. 45]. Theses should be 2-3 pages long.
