- I. **Treasurer's Report** C. Reichl
Through 9/30:

- \$124,000 General fund
- \$10,840 Payroll
- \$4,100 Raffle account (about \$5,230 to date)

- II. **Raffle Update, website, banquet guidelines** M. Callesano
- Raffle is doing well. A couple of teams that haven't sold any for the fall season, but many sold more than they were required to (Expectation is 5 \$20 tickets sold for each level of each program)
 - Good tracking on the website. Each team has their own subpage for the website. Many people coming through our site to get to these subpages or social media pages for each team. Google calendars implemented for each team.
 - Banquet guidelines can be found on the website, which is a great place to start when planning a banquet. There needs to be more specific guidelines added, it will be looked at and updated.

- III. **College Athletics Panel** K. Murray

Held last week. About 80 people in attendance, which is about what was expected for the first one. This is a very competitive time to be applying for colleges and looking to participate in athletics. Hoping to continue each year, but may open up to other schools to create a larger draw for attendance. Open to grades 7th-12th (geared towards 8-10th grades to avoid making mistakes as the process begins). Parent representative in attendance thought it was excellent.

-New job site opportunity

Beginning to have students in age 18-21 classrooms. Will be taking inventory, stocking, cleaning, etc. They will come in weekly to do this.

QUESTIONS:

- Hole in the Wall is extremely busy. Middle School parents not aware of where to go. A note from coaches to remind parents where they should go when volunteering for this duty.
- Q) When does incentive for raffle tickets end? A) Last day of postseason.
- Q) What is the role of the Booster Club for banquets? Is it up to coaches at each level to decide if there will be a banquet? VI. Executive Session

- Open concessions for teams other than football during sectional play, hugely important for many reasons. Would be great to do that in the future.

-Regional play (purchase of student tickets?)

In the past, we have purchased 100 tickets for students. Current ticket price is \$7.40 a ticket. If contest is within 100 miles, we could get district transportation. Albany High does this- with a parent permission slip and student ID. Some difficulty with transferring tickets now that they are digital only. Lots of interest from board members to do this. We just have to look into the logistics.
