

JGMS Dress Code Policy

2024-2025

DSUSD Board policy regarding Dress & Grooming (BP 5132) states: All students shall be required to dress and groom with attention and emphasis on the following: Neatness, Cleanliness, Modesty, Decency, Safety, Personal and Public Health.

The following rules need to be followed to avoid being “dress coded”:

- Clothing worn as a shirt or a blouse must have sleeves or a 1 inch band at the shoulder (tank tops) with no undergarments visible. See-through blouses or shirts, shirts showing midriff or off the shoulder style are not allowed.
- Shorts (one pair or multiple pairs at once) must have inseams of at least 4 inches in length.
- Skirts must extend beyond the fingertips when arms are fully extended at your sides. It is recommended that the appropriate undergarment is worn under the skirt. (the students added this language).
- Pants must be worn on the waist and stay there without the assistance of a belt.
- No pajamas/slippers/bathrobes (except on Spirit days), wallet chains, or spanx by themselves.
- Clothing may not depict any of the following: offensive acts, promotion of drugs or alcohol use, illegal behavior, gambling, racism, gang affiliation, weapons, graffiti, blood, gore or anything that may have lewd or dangerous connotations.
- No hats, visors, or sunglasses may be worn in class.
- Writing on the skin is not permitted.
- All clothing and backpacks must be free from graffiti, tagging or writing promoting ideas that are inappropriate for school.
- Any form of personal expression believed to affect the learning environment negatively is subject to consequences at the discretion of the administration.
