Training Courses By Title

Introduction to Blackboard Ultra (ZERD-190)

In <u>ZERD-190</u>, learn the basics of the Blackboard Learning Management System. Topics include customizing both the student and instructor views, creating, loading and editing content, user management, assessments, grading and more. This course has no prerequisites, but basic computer skills are recommended.

Online Instructional Quality (ZERD-219)

In ZERD-219, learners will be introduced to learning theory and cultural relevance, roles within the learning environment, online course design and alignment strategies, collaboration, and motivation. Emphasis will be placed on facilitating an engaging collaborative learning environment. This course's prerequisite is concurrent enrollment with ZERD-190 or completion of ZERD-190 prior to enrollment.
