# **Option A**

50% off Registration Dues for all players – capped at 4 players per family. No Volunteer Deposit All Fan Wear at Hangtown LL Cost

### **Option B**

Free Registration for 1 player per board member. Rest of players will be full cost.

#### **Option C**

Free Registration for 1 player and 50% off 2<sup>nd</sup> player per family. Rest of players will be full cost. No Volunteer Deposit
All Fan Wear at Hangtown LL Cost

### **Option D**

1 Free Spring Registration per Family and 2 Free Fall Ball Registrations per Family No Volunteer Deposit
All Fan Wear at Hangtown LL Cost

### Board Member Requirements & Incentive Eligibility to be Added to By-Laws

Board Members will be required to fulfill their job duties and attend all Board meetings, position assigned meetings and League functions. Those Board Members missing two unexcused, or 4 total, meetings will be considered inactive members and will be asked to resign by written request of President or Vice President and will not be eligible for future service. Board Members who cannot attend a meeting must give a reason to the President or Vice President prior to meeting to be excused. A Board Member who resigns due to extenuating circumstances such as illness or family needs may be considered for future service. However, any Board Member who does not have an extenuating circumstance and merely quits, being unwilling to fulfill their full commitment as a board member, will not be eligible for future service.

Board Members must have completed LiveScan Fingerprinting, JDP Background Check and Training Courses to receive incentive.

At President and Vice President's discretion, any Board Members who do not fulfill the requirements stated above will have a charge placed on their player(s) account for any discounted registration dues, which will need to be paid in full prior to the start of their next season.
