

# Sound Sources in the HCS Classroom

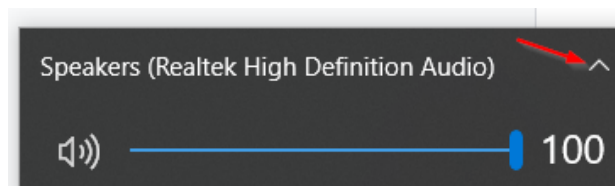
In the K-8 HCS Classroom with Newline Flat Panels, you should have three options for where audio is played when coming from the computer (such as a YouTube video):

- Sound coming directly from the computer (not good quality and very quiet)
- Sound coming from the speakers connected to the Soundfield System
- Sound coming from the Newline Panel's speakers

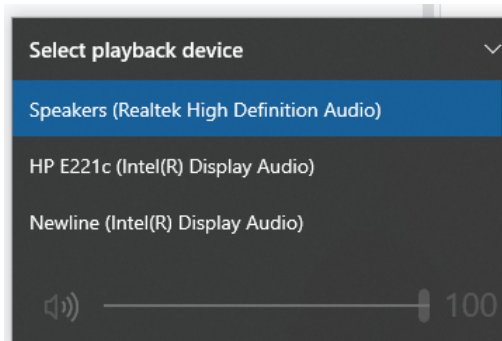
1. To access those different options, simply find the volume icon on in your sys tray (lower right hand corner of the computer) and click on it.



2. Select the dropdown at the top of the volume options.



3. You have three choices from which to select:



- a. When "Speakers (Realtek High Definition Audio)" is selected, the audio will come out of the soundfield speakers in your classroom.
    - i. When this option is selected, you can of course adjust the volume on the soundfield amplifier in your classroom if it is not loud enough.
  - b. When "HP E221c" is selected the audio will come out of the computer box itself.
  - c. When "Newline" is selected, the audio will come out fo the newline speakers.
    - i. When this option is selected, you can use the "secret menu" on the Newline panel to adjust the volume further.
4. Be sure the volume is set at a level you can hear it on the computer and feel free to further adjust the volume using either the soundfield amp or the newline "secret menu" you learned about during training.
