- 3. NetBeez and Raspberry PI dashboard with Curtis Larsen with University of Utah. Manages Wifi for campus, hospital and housing. Troubleshooting can turn into a complicated back and forth. NetBeez created a dashboard that can assist with identifying whether it is a device or system issue. The raspberry pie was pre-configured and sitting at a front desk, if a student had an issue with network connectivity, they could check it out and take it to the vicinity. This tests the full path for the connectivity. The more sites that participate the better! You can trade the devices with other service centers, universities or technical colleges (any institution).

Login with SSO, then select the various type profiles. Follow the prompts to install eduroam profiles. Certs last about 1 year. Servers can be localized in the datacenter, log checking capabilities. The service is built in a way that the support organization (UETN) could provide the Geteduroam server. This can be fully.





10. New Wifi 6e, aka Wifi in the 6Ghz band, requires WPA3-Enterprise. While, we are currently using WPA2-Enterprise. They are kind of compatible with a few issues.

Not all clients support WPA-3, which is required by 6Ghz

Juniper devices will "translate" between the 2 different types

Tweet from Doug Hales at BYU about WPA3 on 5/6GHz single SSID #eduroam

- 1. WPA3 only some clients may fail
- 2. WPA2 transition/WPA3 some clients may fail
- 3. WPA2/WPA3 separate profiles vendor dependent, hard roam possible
- 4. WPA2 only no 6GHz, some clients may still fail

Not an entirely new issue, new bands/tech create this issue each time a new version comes out

Transitions often cause heartburn Hotspot2.0

Whats being done?



- Maybe wait to deploy 6Ghz
- Vendors to add feature
- Create 2 Profiles no roaming, associate and re-associate. The 2 profiles are seen as 2 networks (1 eduroam at lower Ghz, 1 eduroam at 6Ghz)
- Clients will not downgrade due to security
- IEEE have a lot of room for interpretation of device standards, Wifi alliance does good work but compatibility is not a priority

 - Separate VLAN and free filter dns, then let's say if you are from that district
 connect to eduroam with email@samedistrict it will tag the vlan so you end up
 in the schools network instead of bypassing the filter. "Roaming" users not from
 the district will have dns filtering but they can still use their vpn etc and not be
 limited by the filter. Chromebooks and student devices that do connect to
 eduroam will use their current setup, should connect to a filtering cloud solution.
 - This stemmed from a trainer with an issue at a site, there are 3 layers: students, teachers/staff and guests- all go through the filter.




